The total extend of the project area is approximately 386ha and is located in between Ledig and Sun City. The project is planned to deliver an integrated mix of housing typologies totalling 5220 units including:

- 2500 subsidised units (for the indigent),
- 500 institutional units (affordable social housing)
- 2000 bonded units (affordable bonded housing for rental on the basis of a registered long term lease which is capable of being repeatedly renewed, providing secure land tenure to the holder thereof.)
- 220 units (Security Village).

All the residential units will have been connected to waterborne sewerage and other supporting infrastructure as well as supporting social facilities.


