### COMMENTS ON DRAFT AMENDMENT REPORT FOR THE APPLICATION FOR SPLIT AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 25 MARCH 2019 FOR THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF THE 325MW KUDUSBERG WIND ENERGY FACILITY AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE, BETWEEN MATJIESFONTEIN AND SUTHERLAND IN THE WESTERN AND NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCES

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the above-mentioned project dated 25 March 2019, the amendment to the EA dated 04 April 2019, the application for amendment of the EA and the draft motivation report received by the Department on 18 November 2020, and the acknowledgement letter dated 01 December 2020, refer.

The Department has the following comments on the abovementioned amendment application:

#### (a) Amendment Report

- It has been noted that the Draft motivation report does not specify the exact wind energy turbines that will fall within the Oya WEF and which turbines will fall within the Kudusberg WEF. Please ensure that this information is included in the final motivation report.

#### (b) Listed Activities

- The amendment report must include the table of listed activities that applies to each split EA.

#### (c) Layout & Sensitivity Maps

- The final motivation report must include an environmental sensitivity map for each split EA indicating environmental sensitive areas, buffer areas and features identified during the assessment process.
- A copy of the layout map for each split EA must be submitted with the final amendment report. All available biodiversity information must be used in the layout map. The layout map must amongst other things, indicate the following:



- ✓ All supporting onsite infrastructure e.g. roads (existing and proposed) for both Oya WEF and Kudusberg WEF;
- ✓ The location of sensitive environmental features on site e.g. drainage lines etc. that will be affected;
- ✓ Buffer areas; and
- ✓ All "no-go" areas.

**(d) Environmental Management Programme**

- The EMPr and layout map for each split EA to be submitted with the final amendment motivation report must be updated to include and incorporate all mitigation measures recommended by the specialist.

**(e) Public participation**

- Please ensure that copies of original comments received from I&APs and organs of state, which have jurisdiction in respect of the proposed activity are submitted to the Department with the final amendment report. Kindly ensure that the Square Kilometre Array (SKA) comments and comments from this Departments Biodiversity and Conservation Directorate are included in the document.
- Furthermore, ensure that all issues raised and comments received during the circulation of the draft amendment report from registered I&APs and organs of state which have jurisdiction in respect of the proposed activity are adequately addressed in the final amendment report.
- Proof of correspondence with the various stakeholders must be included in the final amendment report. This must indicate that this draft amendment report has been subjected to 30 days public participation process, stating the start and end date of the PPP. Should you be unable to obtain comments, proof should be submitted to the Department of the attempts that were made to obtain comments.

**General**

The Public Participation Process must be conducted in terms of Regulations 39, 40, 41, 42, 43 & 44 of the EIA Regulations 2014, as amended.

You are further reminded to comply with Regulation 32(1)(a) of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended, which states that: *"The applicant must within 90 days of receipt by the competent authority of the application made in terms of regulation 31, submit to the competent authority -*

*(a) a report, reflecting—*

- (i) an assessment of all impacts related to the proposed change;*
- (ii) advantages and disadvantages associated with the proposed change; and*
- (iii) measures to ensure avoidance, management and mitigation of impacts associated with such proposed change; and*
- (iv) any changes to the EMPr;*

*which report-*

*(aa) had been subjected to a public participation process, which had been agreed to by the competent authority, and which was appropriate to bring the proposed change to the attention of potential and registered interested and affected parties, including organs of state, which have jurisdiction in respect of any aspect of the relevant activity, and the competent authority, and*

*(bb) reflects the incorporation of comments received, including any comments of the competent authority."*

Should there be significant changes or new information that has been added to the motivation report or EMPr which changes or information was not contained in the reports or plans consulted on during the initial public participation process, you are required to comply with Regulation 32(1)(b) of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014,



as amended, which states: "the applicant must, within 90 days of receipt of the application by the competent authority, submit to the competent authority – (b) a notification in writing that the report will be submitted within 140 days of receipt of the application by the competent authority, as significant changes have been made or significant new information has been added to the report, which changes or information was not contained in the report consulted on during the initial public participation process contemplated in subregulation (1)(a) and that the revised report will be subjected to another public participation process of at least 30 days".

In the event where subregulation (1)(b) applies, the report which reflects the incorporation of comments received, including any comments of the competent authority, must be submitted to the competent authority within 140 days of receipt of the application by the competent authority.

Should you fail to meet any of the timeframes stipulated in Regulation 32 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended, your application will lapse.

You are hereby reminded of Section 24F of the National Environmental Management Act, Act No 107 of 1998, as amended, that no activity may commence prior to an environmental authorisation being granted by the Department.
