1. Introduction

RBMR requires reagents in support of processing applications at their Magnetic Concentrator (MC) Plant and BMR plants. The chemicals are received, stored and distributed from a centralised bulk chemical storage facility. However, continuous leaks and loss of bund integrity have resulted in the contamination of the current site's substrate resulting in heaving of the foundations. The chemical storage plant therefore needs to be relocated.

A summary of the chemical tanks required at the new location is provided in Table 1.
