Proposed Activity: The construction of two solar PV facilities, each with a contracted capacity of up to 100 MW. The development footprint for each facility is ~300 hectares in extent.

Location: Portions 2 of the farm Woodhouse 729, ~ 7 km South-southeast of Vryburg in the Naledi Local Municipality, Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati District Municipality, North West Province.

Environmental Impact Assessment Process: In terms of Sections 24 and 24D of the National Environmental Management Act (No 107 of 1998), as read with the EIA Regulations (2014) of GN R982 to GN R985, a Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is required to be undertaken for the proposed projects. Savannah Environmental is undertaking the required environmental assessment and public participation process.

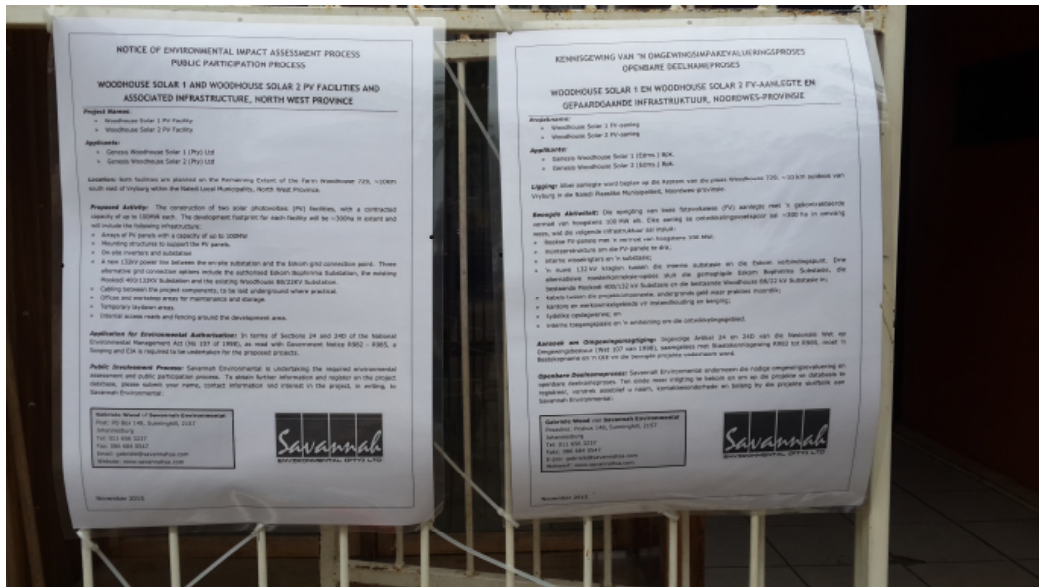


Figure 3: Site notices (English and Afrikaans) placed on the gate of the Vryburg Public Library located within the town of Vryburg: 26° 57' 22.5"S ; 24° 43' 33.5"E

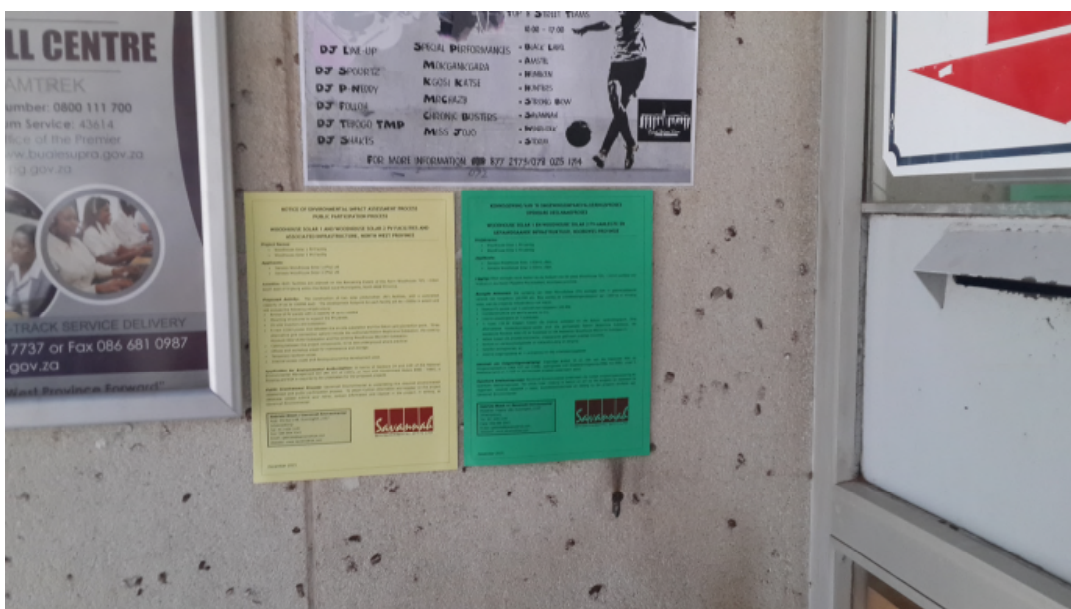
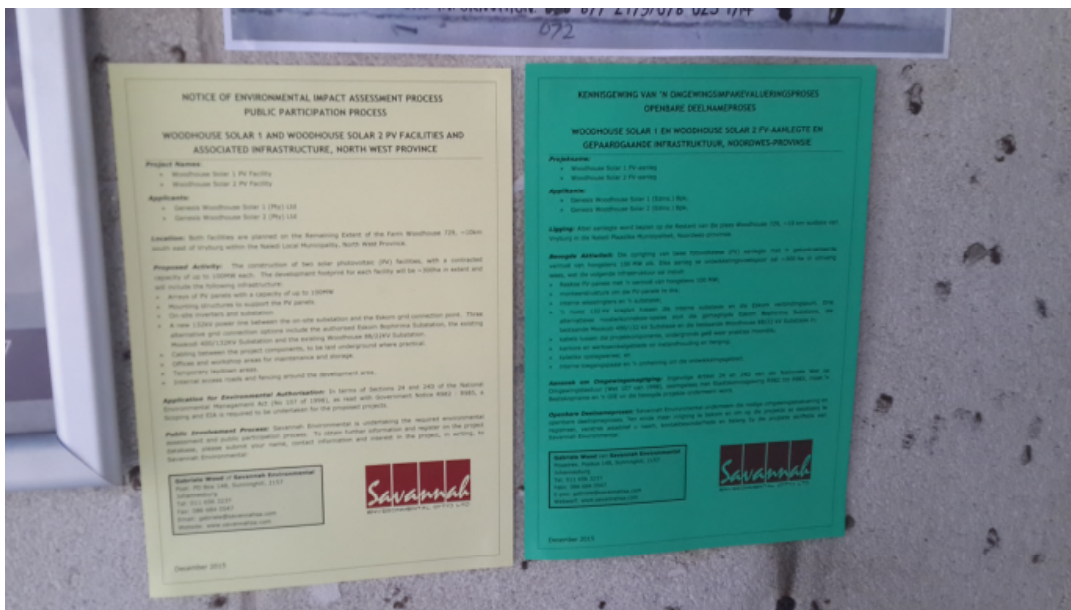


Figure 4: Site notices (English and Afrikaans) placed at the Naledi Local Municipality located within the town of Vryburg: 26° 57' 28.14"S ; 24° 43' 17.78"E
