NOTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY OF EIA REPORT AND PUBLIC MEETING

Paulputs CSP RF (Pty) Ltd proposes the development of a 200MW Concentrated Solar Power (CSP) project and associated infrastructure. The project development site is located on Portion 4 of the Farm Scuitklip 92 which is located approximately 45km north-east of Pofadder within the Khai-Ma Local Municipality in the Northern Cape. The project is referred to as the Paulputs CSP Project.

The purpose of the proposed CSP project is to evacuate the generated power into the Eskom electricity grid. The project is proposed to be bid into the Department of Energy's (DoE) Renewable Energy Independent Power Producers Procurement (REIPPP) Programme.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROCESS

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Paulputs CSP RF (Pty) Ltd has appointed Savannah Environmental (Pty) Ltd as the independent environmental consultant to undertake the required EIA to identify and assess all the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project, and propose appropriate mitigation and management measures in an Environmental Management Programme (EMPr). As part of these environmental studies, Interested and Affected (I&APs) will be actively involved through the public involvement process.

AVAILABILITY OF THE EIA REPORT FOR REVIEW

An EIA Report for the proposed project has been prepared by Savannah Environmental and is available for review. The review period is from **4 May 2016 – 3 June 2016**.
