In terms of sections 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) (Act 107 of 1998) as read with Government Notices R982 to R985 Scoping and EIA processes are required to be undertaken for the proposed projects. The National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) is the competent authority. In order to obtain authorisation, comprehensive, independent environmental studies must be undertaken in accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014. The DEA accepted the Scoping Reports and Plan of Study for both projects in February 2016.

Separate EIA processes have been undertaken for each application. The DEA reference numbers allocated for each project are as follows:

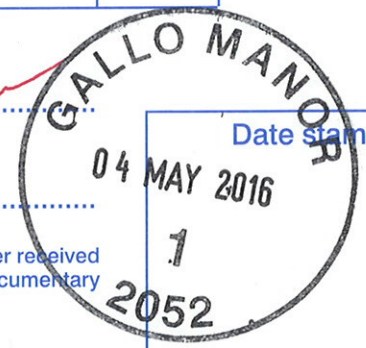
