#### NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF EIA REPORTS FOR REVIEW AND PUBLIC MEETING

Genesis Woodhouse Solar 1 (Pty) Ltd and Genesis Woodhouse Solar 2 (Pty) Ltd proposes the construction of two commercial photovoltaic (PV) solar energy facilities (known as the Woodhouse Solar 1 and Woodhouse Solar 2 PV Facilities) as well as all associated infrastructure on the Remaining Extent of Farm Woodhouse 729, situated approximately 10km south east of Vryburg. The proposed site falls under the jurisdiction of the Naledi Local Municipality and within the greater Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati District Municipality in the North West Province. The contracted capacity of each proposed solar energy facility will be up to 100 MW.

The purpose of the proposed PV facilities will be to evacuate the generated power into the Eskom electricity grid. The projects are proposed to be bid into the Department of Energy's (DoE) Renewable Energy Independent Power Producers Procurement (REIPPP) Programme.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROCESS**

In terms of sections 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) (Act 107 of 1998) as read with Government Notices R982 to R985 Scoping and EIA processes are required to be undertaken for the proposed projects. The National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) is the competent authority. In order to obtain authorisation, comprehensive, independent environmental studies must be undertaken in accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014. 


