3. BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

The Basic Assessment (BA) process will be guided by the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended, published on 4 December 2014 and environmental management principles and objectives of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998). The Environment Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 came into effect on 8 December 2014 in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998).

A Basic Assessment is a process involving consultation with regulatory authorities and other I&APs that serve to inform a decision on whether or not a development is environmentally acceptable.

The Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) in the Western Cape will be the final decision making authority with regard to this project.
