Final Comment

South32 intends to upgrade the existing railway infrastructure at the Wessels Mine. The upgrade will consist of modifications to the staging rail lines and the design of a new rail balloon. The extension of the railway into the new railway balloon measures at approximately 2 500 m long and 25 m wide and would result in the clearing of indigenous vegetation (more than 1 hectare, but less than 20 hectares). Additionally, the railway would cross a section of the existing tailings dam and would thus result in the removal of approximately 15 000 – 25 000 m3 of material from the tailings area, which would then be deposited on another existing tailings dam. The new railway extension would be located within the existing Mining Right (MR) boundary at the Wessels Mine and amendments to the mine's Water Use Licence (WUL) are not required.

SLR Consulting (South Africa)(Pty) Ltd has been appointed by Hotazel Manganese Mines (Pty) Ltd to conduct an Environmental Authorisation (EA) Application for the proposed extension of railway infrastructure at the Wessels Mine, near Hotazel, Northern Cape Province (DMRE Ref: NC-00212-MR/102).

A draft Basic Assessment Report (DBAR) Report has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) and the 2017 NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended). The Directorate: Forestry Management (Other Regions) in the Department of <u>Forestry</u>, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) is responsible for the administration of the National Forests Act, Act 84 of 1998 (NFA) and the National Veld and Forest Fires Act, Act 101 of 1998 (NVFFA) as amended.

A. NATIONAL FORESTS ACT, ACT 84 OF 1998 (AS AMENDED)

- 1. Section 12(1) of the National Forests Act, Act 84 of 1998 (NFA) states that the Minister may declare a particular tree, group of trees, woodland; or trees belonging to a particular species, to be a protected tree, group of trees, woodland or species.
- 2. Section 15(1)(a) of the NFA states that no person may cut, disturb, damage, destroy or remove any protected tree or (b) possess, collect, remove, transport, export, purchase, sell, donate or in any other manner acquire or dispose of any protected tree, or any forest product derived from a protected tree, except under a license granted by the Minister; or in terms of an exemption published by the Minister in the Gazette.
- 3. Section 58(1) read with s62 and s63 states that any person who contravenes the prohibition on protected trees referred to in section 15(1)(a) and s15(1)(b), is guilty of a first category offence and may be sentenced to a fine or imprisonment for a period of up to three years, or both.
- 4. The list of protected trees is published annually in the Government Gazette. See Government Gazette No. 44204, Government Notice, GN 155 of 1 March 2021.

B. PROJECT BACKGROUND

- 5. Hotazel Manganese Mines (Pty) Ltd (HMM), a subsidiary of South32 Limited (South32), owns and operates the underground Wessels Manganese Mine (Wessels Mine) located approximately 1.5 km north-east of Blackrock Mine, in the John Taolo Gaetsewe District Municipality. The project entails the upgrading of the existing railway infrastructure (a single proposed railway loop measuring at approximately 2 500 m long and 25 m wide) at the Wessels Mine. The Wessels Mine is located on the farms Dibiaghomo 226, Wessels 227 and Dikgatlong 268. The proposed project covers an area of approximately 10 ha. The project site is in the Kathu Bushveld vegetation type, in an area classified as Other Natural Areas (ONA), but in the Griqualand West Centre of Endemism. Three habitat units were identified on site:
 - 1) Transformed Area with little to no remaining vegetation
 - 2) Senegalia melifera Thicket Habitat Unit; and
 - 3) Open Mixed Senegalia melifera Vachellia erioloba Vachellia haematoxylon Woodland Habitat




Figure 1: Layout map of the proposed railway link, showing the three habitat types on site.

C. COMMENTS ON BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT AND BIODIVERSITY SPECIALIST REPORT

6. The Basic Assessment Report (BAR) and Biodiversity Assessment Report confirmed the presence of nationally and provincially protected plants in the project footprint, namely *Vachellia erioloba, Vachellia haematoxylon, Harpagophytum procumbents* and *Boophone disticha*. No indication was given of the density of protected trees on site and/or the number of trees that may be impacted on. The developer will therefore need to apply for and obtain a valid Forest Act License, prior to disturbing any protected trees on site. The Department is assessing cumulative impacts on protected trees and once a certain threshold

is exceeded, may ask for a biodiversity offset to be implemented, for impacts on slow-growing, long-lived protected trees that cannot be mitigated.

- 7. Trees with active bird nests or other significant biodiversity features may not be damaged or disturbed without a valid <u>Fauna permit</u> from the provincial Conservation Authority, under the Northern Cape Nature Conservation Act, Act 9 of 2009, if these would be affected.
- 8. The developer must kindly take note of the timeframe to obtain a license. It can take up to 30-days upon receipt of all the requested information, to process the application. Please submit a .kml or .kmz with the license application, as well as an accurate estimation of the tree count (number of protected trees per species affected), as well as the supporting documentation listed in the license application form, i.e., the applicant's I.D. document and a copy of the approved Environmental Authorisation. Should any additional information be required, the Department will inform the applicant upon receipt of the license application form.



Potential Impact of the Proposed Extension of the Railway Infrastructure at the Wessels Mine, Northern Cape on East Manganese

Soil erosion

This region where the mine is situated have very lose sandy soil. Rainfall in the area is associated with very windy conditions. The tree removal with earthworks phase of the project will leave exposed soil which may affect the dust fall of the East Manganese mine.

Dust fall is tested on a monthly basis on the mine and the mine has been compliant thus far. The project may lead to excessive dust and may lead t non-compliance on the mine.

• Chemical pollution of soils

The project will result in contamination of groundwater resources. Based on the Geohydrological report of East Manganese the Regional groundwater flow is mainly in a north-western direction, with localised groundwater flow towards the drainage channels. Boreholes for Ground water testing are situated around the pit; the open pit is located in the in the Ga-Mogara River. There is a possibility that the chemical pollution of soils will be picked up in the quarterly borehole testing of the mine.


