1. Overview

The following document contains copies of the entire Public Participation Process that has been run up to the completion of the Basic Assessment Report (BAR).

The Public Participation Process was planned and facilitated by the independent assessment service provider (EndemicVision Environmental Services) following the following framework:




FIGURE 1: STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT FRAMEWORK

Stakeholder engagement was based on the National Environmental Management Act (Act. No 107 of 1998) and industry best practice guideline by Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning, Guideline on Public Participation 2009. Guidance to stakeholder engagement in further phases will be based on the suggestions that will be made in the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) on the basis of the outcome of the stakeholder engagement process and the subsequent environmental authorization.

Chapter 1 of the NEMA outlines the principles of environmental management, several pertaining to public participation; and

The EIA Regulations promulgated in June 2014 in GN R982, Chapter 6 specify the minimum requirements for public participation in an EIA under NEMA:

The minimum requirements for public participation in an Environmental Impact Assessment under NEMA requiring public participation are sections 54, 55, 56, 57.

The public participation process commenced on 2017/05/11 and the provisional list of stakeholders were notified via SMS Notifications of its commencement.

To date a key stakeholder list has been compiled to determine the key stakeholders that will be engaged in the public participation process. This stakeholder list will continuously be updated throughout the participation process. A Comments & Response Report has also been compiled from all comments received from I & APs.

Communication documents have been drafted and distributed to the general public and identified stakeholders via electronic mail or other requested methods. This includes the Background Information Document (BID); posters and advertisements.

The BID contains the following information:

- A simplified description of the proposed project, and a rationale for it,
- A map indicating the extent of the proposed project area,
- The Environmental Impact Assessment Process and Stakeholder Engagement Process to be followed,

Invitations to register as an I&AP and to participate in the basic Assessment Process and Public Participation Process and a description of how and when stakeholders can contribute during the environmental authorization and Public Participation Process was sent to I&APs via electronic mail, SMS Notifications or other requested methods.

The posters and advertisements indicate that EndemicVision Environmental Services initiated the public participation process for the De Beers Demolition Authorisation in respect of the Buffels Marine Mining Right, Namaqualand, Northern Cape.

Furthermore, it indicated the purpose of the proposed project, the activities that will be undertaken, as well as the fact that a Basic Assessment Report (BAR) process need to be completed in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (No. 107 of 1998) and the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (No. 28 of 2002).

Lastly the advertisement specified that EndemicVision Environmental Services (Pty) Ltd. has been appointed to conduct the Basic Assessment and Public Participation Process for the project. Subsequently stakeholders have been invited to register as I&APs and to participate in the process before or on 2017/05/25.

An advert was placed in the local newspaper 'Die Plattelander' on 19 May 2017 and posters were also distributed in the nearby town, Kleinzee at strategically positioned sites such as the library and other public places on 11 May 2017.

A regulatory waiting period of 30 days has been given for stakeholders to register as interested and/or affected (I&APs).

At the end of the public review period of DBAR / EMP Report, the stakeholder engagement report will be updated and the issues raised and received in writing will be incorporated into the FBAR / EMP Report.

After the competent authorities have accepted/denied the FBAR / EMP Report, registered I&APs will be notified of authorities' decision and appeals procedure.

2. STAKEHOLDER PROFILE

The affected properties are owned by De Beers Consolidated Mines Limited - Namaqualand Mines (DBCM-NM).

Other I&APs include Organs of State, who have jurisdiction over, or may have an interest in the proposed prospecting project. Adjacent landowners, other non-governmental organisations and/or private persons are included. A list of all the stakeholders is listed below and tabled in detail.


FIGURE 3: DE BEERS DEMOLITION PROJECT POSTER




FIGURE 4: PLACEMENT OF POSTERS





De Beers Consolidated Mines Limited - Namaqualand Mines has commenced with demolition activities in respect of the Buffels Marine Mining Right area situated in the administrative district of Namaqualand, in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act No. 28 of 2002) (MPRDA), the National Environmental Management Act (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA), and the National Environmental Management: Waste Act (No. 59 of 2008) (NEMWA). This application has been accepted by Department of Mineral Resources (DMR), and an application for Environmental Authorisation is now required to secure the license and ensure legal compliance.

The Buffels Marine Mining Right area consist of 35 000ha, and stretches approximately 40 km north of Kleinzee to 9km south of Kleinzee, within the Administrative District of the Richtersveld Local Municipality and Nama Khoi Local Municipality within Namakwa District Municipality, Northern Cape Province.

Before the proposed project may go ahead, a Basic Assessment Report (BAR) process needs to be completed in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA), Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (No. 28 of 2002), National Environmental Management: Waste Act (No. 59 of 2008). The submission of a report to the competent authority will contain an assessment of all impacts related to the project with avoidance, mitigation and management measures included in the Environmental Management Programme (EMPr).
