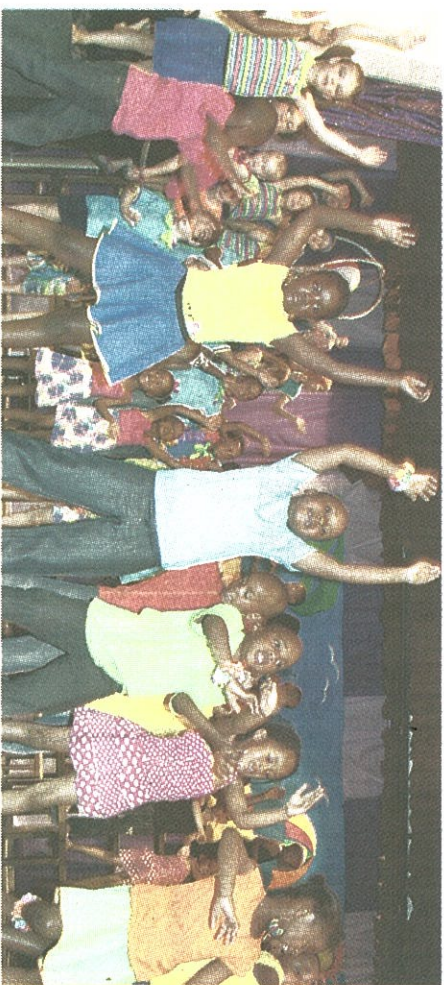

The facility would include the following infrastructure:

- Photovoltaic (PV) or Concentrated Photovoltaic (CPV) panels with an export capacity of up to 75 MW. Panels are proposed to be up to 20m in height (should CPV technology be utilised).
- A new on-site substation to evacuate the power from the facility into the Eskom grid via the Venetia Substation located adjacent to the proposed development site. The alternative would be to connect directly to the existing Transmission line which runs along the north eastern boundary of the site.
- Mounting structure to be either rammed steel piles or piles with pre-manufactured concrete footings to support the P/V/CPV panels.
- Cabling between the project components, to be lain underground where practical.
- Internal access roads and fencing.
- Workshop area for maintenance, storage, and offices

Johan Erasmus: We suggest you remove and keep grass short by mechanical means. Please do not use pesticides as it will affect the environmental and kill all the big trees in the area.	Marc Wright: Comment noted.
Johan Erasmus: Were will your entrance to the site be?	Marc Wright: We will utilise existing roads and upgrade it to a very good state.
Johan Erasmus: Would it be possible for BioTherm Energy to provide the surrounding farmers with a solar power unit that could take them off the grid. A solar power unit that farmers can purchase to make them independent from Eskom.	Marc Wright: I can only note your request at this point.
Frikkie van Heerden: As stated during the scoping phase, the Alldays farmers would like to know how this project would benefit all the surrounding farmers. Can BioTherm support the surrounding farmers through the Alldays Fire Protection Association, the Alldays Water User Association. We need assistance with equipment to maintain safety and security in the area and to fight wild fires. All of our concerns and request were raised in the scoping phase focus group meetings and public meeting.	Marc Wright: I note your comments for the record.
