Platreef Resources (Platreef) intends to apply for a mining right for the mining of Platinum Group Metals (PGM) near Mokopane, Limpopo Province. The project site is located on three adjoining farm properties, Turfspruit 241 KR, Macalacaskop 243 KR and Rietfontein 2 KR, approximately 8 km from the town of Mokopane (previously known as Potgietersrus) in the Mogalakwena Local Municipality within the Waterberg District, Limpopo Province.

- A Mining Right Application (MRA) will be submitted to the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR), Limpopo province in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (Act. No. 28 of 2002) (MPRDA);
- Integrated Water Use Licence (IWUL) as per the National Water Act (Act No 36 of 1998) (NWA)
 from the Department of Water Affairs (Limpopo province); and
- Waste Management Licence as per the National Environmental Management Waste Act (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEM:WA).

Digby Wells Environmental (Digby Wells) is the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) appointed by Platreef to undertake the necessary environmental authorisations and associated public participation processes in support of the above applications.

This notification is being given in compliance with the terms of Section 15 of GN R.543, which requires that landowners and people in control of land to be notified of Platreef's intention to submit an application for the mentioned environmental authorisations to LEDET and other relevant authorities. The notice and the submission of the application form is the first step in the EIA process.

A Background Information Document (BID) will be sent to you in due course. The BID will provide you with a description of the proposed project, the EIA and related authorisation processes, the public participation process and how you as potentially affected stakeholder can participate in the study. A full public participation process will be conducted as an integral part of the EIA application.
