Project Description and Location

This notice serves to inform you of the availability of the Draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report (DEIAR) for public comment and Public Meetings which will be held. This is for the Environmental Authorisation process being undertaken for a proposed underground mine located approximately 10 km north west from the town of Mokopane, in the magisterial district of the Mogalakwena Local Municipality and within the Waterberg District Municipality of the Limpopo Province. Platreef Resources (Pty) Ltd. (Platreef) has applied for a mining right, on the farms Turfspruit 241 KR and Macalacaskop 243 KR and for Environmental Authorisation of Listed Activities on the farm Rietfontein 2 KS.
