Platreef is trying to employ from all the affected communities but not everybody will get a job on the mine. The minimum requirement for employment is grade 12, but there will also be jobs created for unskilled people who are not in possession of a grade 12 certificate.

There will also be a training centre where training for welding, plumbing etc. will be provided. Bursaries have been given to young people in the engineering field.


