NOTICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORIZATION APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998 NEMA) as well as the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014 (as amended) that Lonaca Mining Services (Pty) Ltd ("Applicant") applied for:

• Environmental Authorization to stockpile and sell material as a commercial product on portion 240 of the Farm Zwartkops 356 JR, City of Tshwane, Gauteng Province.

The above-mentioned area is a site previously used for mining purposes.
