IMPACT STATEMENT: Waterloo Photovoltaic Solar Energy Facility near Vryburg, North West Province – Expansion of facility footprint

Phala Environmental Consultants was contacted by Environamics Environmental Consultants on the 6th of June 2016 regarding a 19 hectares expansion on the Waterloo Photovoltaic Solar Energy Facility near Vryburg in the North West province.

Dr L.A. Sandham conducted a Visual Impact Assessment during September 2012 on the original footprint of the solar plant. The report dated September 2012 “*Visual Impact Assessment of site for proposed Photovoltaic (PV) Solar facility on a portion of the farm Waterloo 992 IN located in the Naledi Local Municipality Vryburg Northern Cape Province*” was studied by Phala Environmental Consultants to determine if a Visual Impact Assessment will be necessary for the 19 hectares expansion.

Phala Environmental Consultants do not perceive the need for a new study to be conducted as, from a visual impact point of view, a new study will deliver the same results as the one conducted in September 2012.
