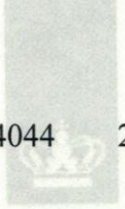

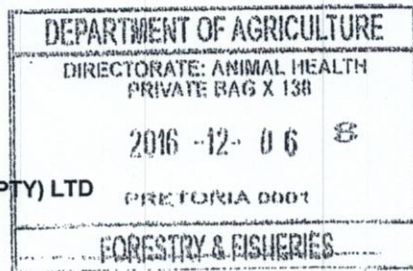

VETERINARY IMPORT PERMIT / INTRANSIT PERMIT FOR THE INTRODUCTION OF OVA OF THE FAMILY SALMONIDAE INTO SOUTH AFRICA (Issued in terms of the Animal Diseases Act, 1984)

Authority is hereby granted for you to import into Republic of South Africa:

Oncorhynchus mykiss (Rainbow trout), quantity 300 000

To be supplied by: AQUASEARCH OVA APS, SILJEAGER 1, JELLING DK, BILLUND, DENMARK subject to the following conditions:

1. The consignment must be accompanied by this original permit and the attached health certificate (IMP.TROUTOVA.SF08/05), completed and signed by an authorised veterinarian or authorised fish pathologist of the country of origin.
2. This permit is valid for ONE CONSIGNMENT ONLY
3. The salmonid or trout ova imported by air for immediate re-export to N/A need not comply with the above mentioned health certificate and point 6 and 7 of this import permit.
4. The import will take place through the port at: CAPE TOWN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT
5. The arrival of the consignment must timeously be reported at the port of entry to the State Veterinarian, Quarantine Master or Veterinary Official at CAPE TOWN tel. no: 021 551 2050 fax. no: 021 551 1378, before arrival of the consignment and may not be landed without his/her written permission.
OR for intransit consignments the date of dispatch and intended date of arrival of the consignment at N/A is to be reported timeously by the importer to the State Veterinarian or Veterinary Official :N/A Tel:N/A Fax:N/A who will inspect the consignment and documentation before export to N/A. The trout ova must depart within 24 hours of arrival at the intransit airport.
6. On arrival in South Africa, a representative sample of the consignment must be sent for post-import testing for Viral Haemorrhagic Septicaemia (VHS), Infectious Pancreatic Necrosis (IPN), Infectious Haematopoietic Necrosis (IHN), and Bacterial Kidney Disease by Dr. Lubisi at the Fish Diagnostic Unit (Onderstepoort Veterinary Institute) Tel.(012)529 9117. Testing Confirmation of these arrangements must be provided to Quarantine Master/Veterinary Official.
7. The consignment must be held in isolation on the farm of destination and will only be released from on-farm-isolation once negative results of post-import testing are available. The responsible state veterinarian at the facility is DION VISSER and his/her fax number is 021 551 1378.
8. This permit is subject to amendment or cancellation by the Director Animal Health at any time and without prior notice being given.

I certify that-

1. The ova originate from aquaculture farms who are all under the supervision of the competent authority.
2. Representative samples of the brood stock from which the above-specified-eggs originated, were inspected and tested during the present spawning season, and have been similarly tested for the past 2 years at intervals of approximately six months and have on each occasion been free of the diseases (a) to (e) below:
 - a. Viral Haemorrhagic Septicaemia (VHS);
 - b. Infectious Pancreatic Necrosis (IPN); and
 - c. Infectious Haematopoietic Necrosis (IHN);
 - d. Bacterial Kidney Disease
 - e. Infectious Salmon Anaemia
3. All the stock at this farm were found to be free of these diseases named above during the past two years;
4. The ova originate from a farm which at the time of the year Gyrodactylus salaris is expected to manifest itself, has for at least two years been subject to inspections by the competent authorities, including sampling or surveillance methods described in the OIE Manual of diagnostic tests for aquatic animals and laboratory tests having been carried out in accordance with that OIE Manual giving only negative results

5. According to a declaration by the exporter, this batch of eggs was disinfected with iodophore in accordance with the latest OIE Aquatic Code, immediately prior to export ensuring the elimination of Gyrodactylus salaris.
6. The transport container is clean and disinfected or previously unused.
