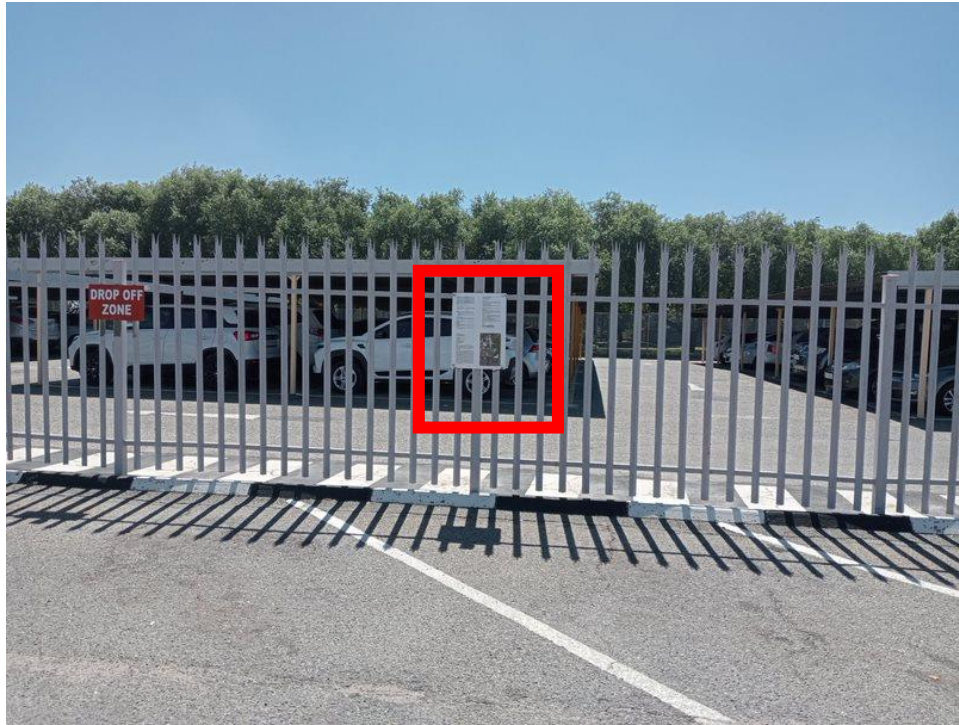

Picture 1 : Site Notice Picture at the Parking Area outside the Reception Area of Element Six.

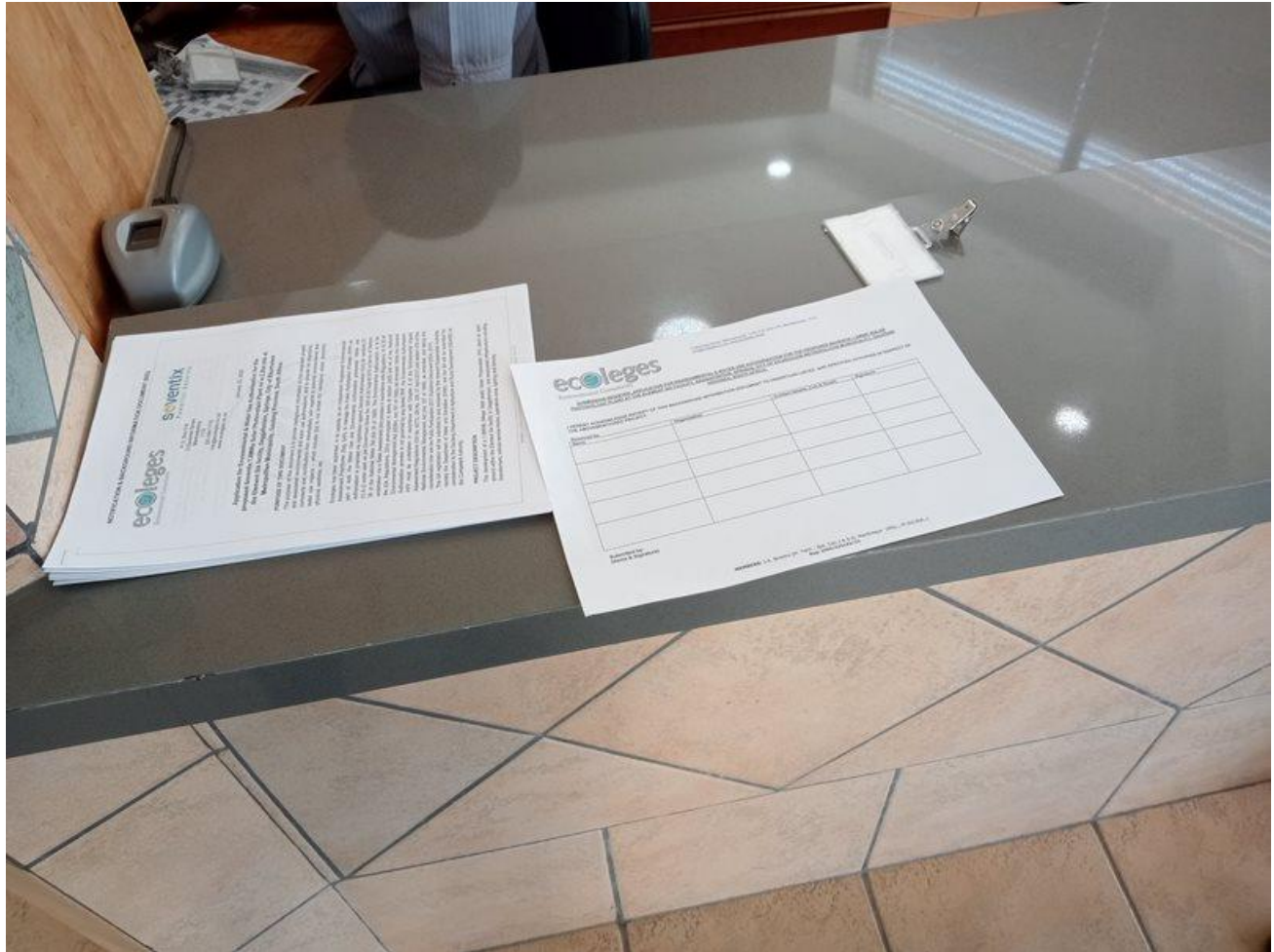


Picture 2 : Site Notice Picture on the fence at the entrance turnoff towards the Element Six facility.

Good morning Ladies and Gentlemen,

Kindly find attached the Background Information Document (BID) for the proposed development of a ground-mounted 1.8MWp solar photo voltaic (PV) plant within the Element Six facility on erf 256 Nuffield Township, Registration Division I.R., in the City of Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality, Springs region of Gauteng Province, South Africa.
