2.	CC: Will you be using existing roads and do you have a detailed design of the roads?	SJ: Existing access roads will be used as far as possible and new access roads will also be constructed as per the proposed layout provided.
3.	CC. Do you have a detailed storm water plan in place?	<i>BK</i> : A storm water management plan has been drafted and will form part of the EMP.
4.	CC: Will turbines be placed in or near drainage areas.	<i>MvN</i> : No turbines will be placed in drainage lines.
5.	CC: Do you have exact positions where the access roads will cross the drainage lines? Both new and proposed.	MvN: 8 crossing have been identified at this stage as per the map provided to you and we can go to any of these crossing so that you can get an understanding of the drainage lines we will cross
6.	CC: Where will you get your water for the construction period?	<i>MvN:</i> Our current proposal is get our water from the Alkantpan testing range.
7.	CC: Are they a registered water user and do they have capacity to supply your project with water?	<i>MvN:</i> We have been informed they are a registered user and we will confirm the capacity with them.
8.	MvN: How best do you think we should cross the drainage lines?	CC: Only your technical assessments and designs can recommend the right methods of crossing. However, as the Department we will make recommendation on your proposed crossings should that be required.
9.	CC: The following information will be required for a water use licence: » Coordinates of each of the crossings » Where water for construction be sourced from » Rezoning information » Environmental Authorisation » Lease agreement » Landowners title deed However, water use licence can only be issued once you are preferred bidder and another site visit would be required at that stage.	BK: Comment noted.





PROJECT COMPONENTS


- » Up to 58 wind turbines.
- » Steel tower, of up to 100m high, a nacelle & three rotor blades with a rotor diameter (120m)
- » Concrete foundations
- » Underground cabling
- » Internal access roads
- » On-site substation
- » Overhead power line
 - Option 1: Loop in and out of the existing Burchell-Cuprum 132 kV line; or
 - ❖ Option 2: Connect directly to the existing Eskom Caprum Substation via a 132 kV power line. Different sub alternatives considered



HOW DOES A WIND ENERGY FACILITY OPERATE?














ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS INDENTIFIED
