


Public Participation






Figure 3: Background Information Document




Figure 4: Notification sent to the Free State Department of Water and Sanitation




Figure 5: Notification sent to the Nala Local Municipality-Municipal Manager




Figure 6: Notification sent to the Farm Botha's Drift Landowner




Figure 7: Notification sent to the Farm Winkelplaats Landowner




Figure 9: Notification sent to the Free State Department of Police, Roads, and Transport




Figure 10: Notification sent to the Ward Councillor




Figure 11: Notification sent to Free State Eskom Operating Unit




Figure 12: Notification sent to the Free State Department of Agriculture and Rural Development




Figure 13: Notification sent to the South African Heritage Agency




Figure 14: Response from Department of Police, Roads, and Transport

- 3.3 The condition of the provincial gravel road S722 is not in a good condition. - 3.4 No work on bridge structure no. 244 may be done without prior consultation with and approval by this Department. An application for any intended work on the above-mentioned bridge structure must therefore be timeously submitted to this Department for consideration. The application must also be accompanied by appropriate drawings.
- 3.5 Please note that the raising of the level of the water of a river, spruit or dam, to encroach upon a public road, is not allowed in terms of section 20(1)(b) of the Roads Ordinance, 1968.
