






Photo 6- E-mail to SENWES




Photo 8 E-mail to a Farmer/ Landowner Mr Touder




Photo 9 E-mail to Farmer/Landowner Mr Bertram




Photo 10 E-mail to Farmer/Landowner- MS Botha




Figure 3 E-mail sent to Telkom- Mr Mothobi




Figure 4 E-mail sent to Department of Water and Sanitation-Mr Nel




Figure 5 Email sent to Eskom- Ms Burger




Figure 6 E-mail to Department of Roads and Transport- Mr Naude




Figure 7 E-mail to Department of Agriculture- Mr Ndumo
