Location: The proposed Skuitdrift Solar Facility will be developed on Farm Skuidrift 426, located approximately 50km north west of Augrabies in the Kai!-Garib Local Municipality of the Northern Cape Province

Environmental Impact Assessment Process: In terms of Sections 24 and 24D of the National Environmental Management Act (No 107 of 1998), as read with the EIA Regulations (2014) of GN R982 to GN R985, a Basic Assessment is required to be undertaken for the proposed project. An application has been submitted to the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) as the competent authority for the proposed project. Savannah Environmental is undertaking the required environmental assessment and public participation process.
