


Figure 4: Site Notice Placed at the Postmasburg Public Library in Postmasburg

POSTMASBURG. Die Postmasburg Register het op die 13de Augustus besoek afgelê by die stortingssterrein in Postmasburg na 'n wenk van 'n gemeenskapswerker en op 'n groepie mense afgekom wat hul intrek hier geneem het.

Die gemeenskapswerker het ook aangedui dat daar glo gereelde gevalle van bestialiteit voorkom en meer spesifieke hondeseks. Die asgatte, wat langs

die Beeshoekpad, oorkant Postmasburg Steenwerke en agter Boichoko lê, is beter bekend as Spookspan in die volksmond.

'n Paar manne, van wisselende ouderdom het aangedui dat hulle wel hier oornag, aangesien hulle geen ander heenkome het nie. Daar was selfs vier minderjariges wat deel van die mensekolonie was. Die groep was effe stram om met ons te praat en die minderjariges het selfs laat spaander die rotse in,

Tog was dit hartseer om te sien hoe skarrel die ashoopbevolking nader, as 'n trok iets kom aflaai. Die stank van verrotte en half ontbinde materiaal hang onmenslik in die lug, tog het dit huis vir die sowat vyftien mense geword. Een van die ashoopbewoners het ons die plek gaan wys waar hulle snags slap. 'n Konstruksiemaatskappy was met ons besoek besig om 'n gedeelte van die stortingssterrein te rehabiliteer. Dit was duidelik dat die ashoopbewoners blootgestel was aan soveel

gesondheidsrisiko's waaronder stof, stank en vrot kos. Alhoewel al die ashoopbewoners die beweringe van walgdade met honde as belaglik afgemaak het, was daar wel 'n klomp honde wat tussen die groepie saamgetrop het.

GRUSAME ONTDEKKING: NOG 'N LYK IN MOGOROSISTRAAT

POSTMASBURG. 'n Inwoner van 16 Mogorosistraat het hier in die vroeëoggendure van Vrydag die 13de September 'n grusame ontdekking op sy werf gemaak.

"Ek was oppad na die toilet, toe ek die liggaam van 'n jong vrou onder die boom in my jaarts ontdek." Die vermoorde liggaam is uitgeken deur omstanders as die van Monina de Koker, 'n jong vrou wat vroeër by Spar gewerk het. Volgens omstanders is die oorledene se vriendin, een Shiela van Grobbelaarshoop, 'n paar maande

gelede amper op dieselfde plek langs Lizzy's Lounge vermoor. Jackson Lesetedi, beter bekend as Thapelo, het vertel hoe hy op die half naakte liggaam afgekom het. "Ek is te gesok om nou te gaan werk," het hy aan die Postmasburg Register vertel. Getuienis op die toneel dui daarop aan dat daar ten minste 'n poging tot verkragting was. Die

oorledene se broek en onderklere was tot op die knieë afgetrek.

'n Bottelkop, wat vermoedelik die moordwapen is, is ook op die toneel gevind. Mnr Lawrence Khumalo, ondersekretaris van die Gemeenskapspolisiëringforum, wat ook in die huis bly waar die liggaaam ontdek was, het geskok gereageer op die grusame vonds.

"Ons gemeenskap is nie meer veilig nie," het hy gesê. Bronne dui aan dat Monina die vorige aand saam met haar kērel en twee ander onbekende mans opgemerk is. Die kērel dra glo sy hare in rastastyl en niemand ken sy naam nie.

Apostel Roman, 'n pastorale leier wat 'n paar meter van die moordtoneel bly, het sy ontevredenheid met kuiperplekkie in die omgewing uitgespreek. "Kan die polisie nie tavernes vra om 'n sekere tyd snags toe te maak nie?" wou hy weet. 'n Bloedstreep op die toneel het etlike meters ver geloop. Ons begrawe te veel mense," het 'n onbekende vrou kopskuddend gesê.
