

ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION AND LICENSING FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF 500MM STEEL WATERMAIN INLET TO WESTRIDING RESERVOIR, DURBAN, KWAZULU-NATAL PROVINCE

Notice is hereby given that eThekwini Water and Sanitation has applied for environmental authorisation and a Water Use Licence Application (WULA) for the proposed construction of 4km of a 500mm steel watermain and inlet to Westriding Reservoir, Durban, KwaZulu-Natal Province.

The Environmental Authorisation and Licensing is conducted in accordance with the following legislation:

- Environmental Authorisation from the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Agriculture and Environmental Affairs (DAEA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No 107 of 1998) (NEMA) and Associated Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (GNR. 544 and 546, 18 June 2010).
- Section 21 (c) & (i) of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) (NWA)

PROJECT LOCATION and DESCRIPTION

The proposed project is located in Hillcrest Durban, which falls within the jurisdiction of the eThekwini Municipality, KwaZulu-Natal Province. The project will involve the installation of approximately 4km of 500mmØ continuously welded steel pipe along an aqueduct at the corner of Gevers and Assagay Road and along Assagay Road to Old Main Road. The pipe will also be pipe jacked in a sleeve of a minimum diameter of 900mm across Old Main Road.

ENVIRONMENTAL BASIC ASSESSMENT, WULA AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS
