STUDY AREA

The proposed activity falls on Mooifontein Farm No 14IR portion 22 in the Ekurhuleni Metro Municipality. The applicant is the owner of the proposed land. Refer to Figure 1 – Locality Map

SITE DESCRIPTION

Mooifontein Farm is currently zoned agricultural although there is not much farming taking place. Rather the place is now being used by locals as a dumping site. Sky Coverage Town planners are in the process of applying for the rezoning of the area into residential status.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

JG Joubert wishes to construct two double storey building with a capacity of 40 units per hectare. Sky coverage the town planners are currently running a process of obtaining a license to have the site zoned as residential for the purpose of township establishment.
