NEMA PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

**PROPOSED BULK WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM ONSEEPKANS, ONSEEPKANS SETTLEMENT, KHAI MA
MUNICIPALITY, NORTHERN CAPE**

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit an application, and the public participation, process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014. The proposed Onseepkans Bulk Water Supply System includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by the Dept. of Agriculture, Land Reform & Rural Development, to undertake the NEMA Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

Application for environmental authorization to undertake the following activities:

Government Notice R983 (Listing Notice 1): Activity No. **1, 9, 11, 12, 13, 19, 27, 45**

Government Notice R984 (Listing Notice 2): Activity No. N/A

Government Notice R985 (Listing Notice 3): Activity No. **2, 12, 14**

**Please note that the listed activities above may change during the course of the NEMA Application process. Registered I&APs will be notified.*

Project Description & Location: It is proposed that the bulk water supply system in Onseepkans be re-constructed. This will include the construction of a storage reservoir (with a capacity of 100 000m³ and an area of approximately 2.5ha in size) and a Solar plant (consisting of PV panels, which will generate between 750 KVA and 1MVA, with an area not larger than 1 ha, as well as distributions cables) on Farm No. 88. Approximate location of the storage reservoir: **28°45'40.02"S, 19°17'00.74"E**. Approximate location of the solar farm: **28°45'11.88"S, 19°16'51.43"E**

The pipeline from the pump station to the storage dam will also be constructed. The pipeline will be 2200m in length with a diameter of 1000mm and a maximum flow rate of 3350m³/h.

A Sand Filter Installation and pump station will be constructed on Farm 209 next to the Orange River. Approximate location of the sand filter installation: **28°44'45.43"S, 19°16'36.03"E**. Approximate location of the pumpstation: **28°44'44.92"S, 19°16'28.61"E**

Public Participation: Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) are hereby notified of the application and invited to register (in writing) and/or provide initial comments and identify any issues, concerns or opportunities relating to this project to the contact details provided below, **on or before 09 December 2015**. - will be notified of the applicant's intention to appeal the decision of the competent authority, together with an indication of where and for what period the appeal submission will be available for inspection.
