

# Basic Assessment and Water Use License application for the proposed upgrade of the existing Bushkoppie WwTW in the Gauteng province.

Notice is hereby given in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, No. 107 of 1998 (NEMA), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014, as amended (GN R.982) of the intention to upgrade the existing Bushkoppie WwTW in the Gauteng province. The proposed upgrade will trigger activities in terms of Listing Notice 1 (GN R.983) and Listing Notice 3 (GN R.985) of the EIA regulations, 2014 (as amended), therefore a Basic Assessment Process is being undertaken.

Johannesburg Water is proposing, as part of upgrading and refurbishment of the Bushkoppie WwTW to construct two new Primary Sedimentation Tanks (PSTs); construction of grit drying beds (GDB); the construction of new wash water pump station (WWPS) and associated infrastructure to assist the Works with the processing of the sewage inflow it receives.

A Water Use License Application (WULA) will also be submitted in accordance with the National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998), as amended.

The Basic Assessment Report will be available for public review and comment from 25 October 2019 to 25 November 2019 at the following public venue:
