NOTICE OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION PROCESS AND A WATER USE LICENCE APPLICATION FOR THE PROPOSED DELMORE PARK EXTENSION 8 DEVELOPMENT BULK SERVICES LOCATED IN BOKSBURG, GAUTEN PROVINCE

The City of Ekurhuleni has been granted environmental authorisation by the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD) to develop the proposed Delmore Park Extension 8 housing development in Boksburg (Reference number GAUT 002/18-19/E2183). The proposed development requires bulk services, including water and sewer lines. Prior to construction of these pipelines, environmental authorisation and a Water Use Licence need to be applied for.

The proposed bulk services for the Delmore Park Extension 8 development triggers various activities listed in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations contained in Government Notice (GN) 324 and 327 (7 April 2017). As these listed activities are triggered, a Basic Assessment environmental authorisation process will be followed. In addition, a Water Use Licence Application will be submitted to the Department of Water Affairs for Section 21 (c) and (i) water uses as detailed in Section 21 of the National Water Act (Act No. 36 of 1998) (NWA).

Alta van Dyk Environmental Consultants (AVDE) was appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake the environmental authorisation and Water Use Licence Application and associated public participation process.
