The City of Ekurhuleni has been granted environmental authorisation by the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD) to develop the proposed Delmore Park Extension 8 housing development in Boksburg. (Reference number: GAUT 002/18-19/E2183). The proposed development requires bulk services, including water and sewer lines.

Alta van Dyk, Environmental Consultants cc (ANDE) has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner to undertake the required environmental related applications and associated public participation process for the proposed bulk services project.

The environmental related applications required for the proposed bulk services are as follows:
• A Basic Assessment process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) (NEMA) and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations. The competent authority for this process is the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD).
• A Water Use Licence Application (WULA) in terms of the National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998). The competent authority for this process is the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS).
