BASIC ASSESSMENT AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

EXPANSION OF LIQUID OXYGEN (LOX) AND DIESEL STORAGE AT THE AIR PRODUCTS FACILITY LOCATED WITHIN THE COEGA SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONE, PORT ELIZABETH, EASTERN CAPE PROVINCE

NOTICE OF BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS and AVAILABILITY OF THE BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT

Air Products (Pty) Ltd operate a site at Coega Special Economic Zone (SEZ) situated in Port Elizabeth, Eastern Cape Province, where Liquid Oxygen (LOX) and Liquid Nitrogen (LIN) are currently handled and stored. APSA is proposing to increase the current LOX storage capacity at this site. The LOX storage capacity will be expanded by an additional 127,3 m³ to a total of 200 m³ either by alternatives of adding an addition vertical storage tank with total capacity of 127,3 m³ or by replacement of the existing tank with a 200 m³ LOX tank. In addition, APSA intends to add 23 000 litres (23 m³) of above ground diesel storage facility at the site for use for the Air Products trucks that are based in Port Elizabeth.

The proposed expansion is to take place at the existing Air Products facility located in Coega, Eastern Cape, as the expansion will occur within the existing site and within the Coega Special Economic Zone (SEZ) the site is considered to be a brownfields site.

Infrastructure associated with the expansion of the facility will include:

- » 1 x 127,3 m³ double walled vacuum insulated horizontal LOX tank or replacement of the existing 72,7 m³ LOX tank with a 200 m³ LOX tank ; ;
- » 1 x 23 m³ aboveground composite diesel tank and associated bund wall, spill slab and separator pit; and
- » 1 x diesel standard pump installation with 2 hoses and shut off valve.

An Application for Authorisation was previously lodged with the Department of Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEDEAT) on 22 November 2019 (DEDEAT Ref.: ECm1/C/LN1/M/40-2019) for the expansion of LOX and diesel storage at the Air Products site. This application was subsequently withdrawn on the 06 November 2019 due to the reconsideration of the layout of storage infrastructure at the site.

Please refer to the Background Information Document (BID) for further information on the proposed expansion.

BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

As per the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended, published in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act No 107 of 1998), the applicant will require authorisation from the Eastern Cape Department of Economic Development, Environmental Affairs & Tourism (EC DEDEAT) for the undertaking of the projects. In terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended, the phasing of an activity, where any phase of the activity was below a threshold but where a combination of the phases, including expansions or extensions, will exceed a specified threshold, requires Environmental Authorisation. The Storage and Handling of Petroleum Products is listed under Subcategory 2.4. Subcategory 2.4 is applicable to all permanent immobile liquid storage facilities at a single site with a combined storage capacity of greater than 1 000 m³. An application for Environmental Authorisation will be submitted for the project to the DEDEAT. It is understood that the maximum storage of the facility will total 223 m³ and therefore the on-site storage will not exceed 1 000 m³. The facility therefore falls below the Subcategory 2.4 threshold and does not require an Atmospheric Emissions Licence (AEL) at the current planned capacity.

The application is required to be supported by comprehensive, independent environmental studies undertaken in accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended.

Air Products (Pty) Ltd appointed Savannah Environmental, as the independent environmental consultant, to undertake the Basic Assessment to identify and assess all potential environmental impacts associated with the projects and recommend appropriate mitigation measures in the Environmental Management Programmes (EMPRs). The public participation processes for the projects will be undertaken concurrently, providing the public with an opportunity to understand and comment on the project. As part of the environmental studies, Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) will be actively involved through the public involvement process being undertaken by Savannah Environmental.

You and/or the organisation which you represent have been identified as an I&AP for the proposed Expansion of Liquid Oxygen (LOX) and Diesel Storage project. In terms of the Environmental Impact Assess Regulations, 2014, as amended, Regulations 42(b) and (c), should you and/or the organisation that you represent have an interest in this project, please register yourself as an I&AP by completing and returning the attached registration/comment form. By registering on the project database, you will receive all information relating to the project and will be provided with an opportunity to provide comment and input into the BA processes. Included in this notification letter is a registration and comment form for your perusal.
