Ms Hughes let Mr. Sello know the process is in its initial phase whereby the public in the vicinity of the proposed study area is being informed about the project. Then a Basic Assessment process involving specialist assessments of the study area ~~studies~~ will be undertaken, The A report will be prepared and submitted to the DEA for decision-making on whether Eskom may construct the proposed lines near & within Watershed SS. This process takes approx. 8 months. Only once Eskom has been granted permission by the DEA to go-ahead with the activity, will construction arrangements take place. This would be the time where job opportunities may arise. Most of the envisaged jobs will be highly skilled (required to construct powerlines) but several unskilled job opportunities may arise & will be the responsibility of the appointed contractor.
