Die begin van die jaar is die tyd wanneer die Suid-Afrikaanse roosdruen Leahy Tashner families aanspoedig om hul rose noukeurig te beskik. Anders as wintersnoei, waar al die roosbosse algees word, veris somersnoei 'n besondering van elke individuele bos. Dit moet dan doelgerig en met 'n spesifieke doel in gedagte gesnoei word.

Roosbosse wat gereeld doosle koppe het, het min snoeiwerk nodig. Wanneer roosbosse egter 'n digte bos gevorm het, word die binneste blare oorskadu.

Nooit die sonlig binne
As jy wil hê jou rose moet deur die winter blom, moet jy jou roosbos genoeg "openmaak" sodat die sonlig op al die blare kan val, sê Tashner.

Verwyder alle oorsvaggies - sodra hulle vorm, hou die roos op met blom. Dun jou roosbos van die middel uit. Los sowaar vier of vyf sterk groeiende stengels agter maar sny hulle met 'n derde tot 50% terug. Dit soort somersnoei is veral voordelig vir buesierkers omdat dit die bosse aanspoedig om van laer af te spruit. Behou 'n goeie balans van blare op die bos om die sap

tussen die wortels en blare te laat vloei.

Snoei geleidelik terug
Rose wat te hoog geteel het, kan ook teruggesnoei word. Die veiligste manier om dit in die warm weer te doen, is geleidelik. Doen dit oor 'n tydperk van twee tot drie weke. Daar dit blafbeskerming te doen, word die blaarbedekking nie drasties verminder nie en word die sapvloed van die plant nie ontwrig nie.

Stut en bind klammers op
Indien klimmers handig gekap het, is dit die beste om die lang nuwe lote so horisontaal moontlik op 'n draadwerk of stutstam vas te bind. Dit moedig blomme in die lengte van die stam aan. Van die ouer stamme kan uitgesny word om vir nuwe groei ruimte te bied.

Hou voete droog
Met goeie rûn is veral nat vrede 'n kopsorg vir rooskekers. Weens steek dreinerings word daar met versuipting op woorde beskikbaar.

Versuip die rose groei nie goed nie. Die blare kan geelgroom word of selfs verlep. As die rose uitgegrawe word, is

die wortels vlak en groot dit paa terwyf hulle stamot soek. Herplant die rose in 'n verhoogde bedding, minstens 30 cm hoog. Werk organiese stowwe soos grondboonoppie in om die dreineringsprobleme op te los. In baie nat gebiede moet die beddings opgedig of dreineringspyp geplaas word.

Behandel swartvlek
Die swamsiekte swartvlek is nog 'n ernstige probleem wat rooskekers moet versigtig met voorkomende reël.

Wanneer roosblare ses tot agter na is, word die swartvlekspore aktief en dring dit die roosblaar binne. As dit nie behandel word nie, versprei swartvlek na al die blare, wat dan doodgaan en afval. Dit stel die stengels bloot aan sonbrand en uiteindelek stamkanker, wat die roos doodmaak.

A South African student has been named the global winner of the People Planet Product Student Design Challenge.

The challenge was launched last year in collaboration with the company's global social enterprise partner, The Washing Machine Project, which is a humanitarian initiative dedicated to alleviating the burden of hand-washing in low-income and displaced communities through innovative product design and distribution.

Kai Goodall's Pedal n Spin design is a foot-powered washing machine that rotates easily using the principles of a treadle and pedal system. The pedal-powered rotating drum washing machine system is purely mechanical in nature and improves the user's posture.

Goodall is a master's student in Electrical Engineering at the University of Cape Town.

"Being the sole finalist from Africa in the competition and winning first prize was a special recognition of my invention," he said.

"It motivates me to take my passion to new frontiers and inspire more young people to use engineering as a tool for their progress."

According to Navot Sushney, panel judge and founder of The Washing Machine Project, the participating students are the scientists, engineers and mathematicians of tomorrow.

Wrenchville matric results impress

The 2021 matric results for Wrenchville High School have not only been impressive but also inspirational at the institution particularly learners at their best. The school churned out a 72.8% pass rate, a pleasant result by any standard. The school principal, Mr Emmanuel Molele, said of the 120 learners, 25 achieved the bachelor's degree entry point with the rest scoring the diploma access points.

He said that this year the motivation is sort of "homemade" because the 2021 class demonstrated to the lower grades that nothing is impossible through commitment and dedication. He said an exceptional pass rate at any given school sets the pace for those at the back to emulate and aspire to do better.

The book by Chinua Achebe titled Things Fall Apart says, "When there is a big tree, the young ones climb its trunk to reach the sun". This means where there is an example the younger ones will follow suit or simply imitate. The Kathu Gazette had the chance to interview learners at the school from various grades. They all expressed the same appetite that hyped up the 2021 matriculants, the vervoer to excel.

Clarence Yeboro said that what their peers produced in 2021 simply gives the impression that the school has the potential to produce even better results. He believes educators are giving their best and learners, on their positive side, should reciprocate.

Echiding similar sentiments was Rachelone Tloko who said that the performance bar has been raised and those at the helm must follow the trend because the administration and teaching staff is giving it all to benefit learners. Molele Kgibo and Mpho Mofheke said they believe that the school can do even better as authorities at the school are doing their best to ensure the learning environment favours better results.

The secret behind better performing schools universally, revolves around discipline. Any signs of defiance in that direction leads to finger-pointing. Spare the rod and spoil the child. But is not all about spanking but enforcing strict rules and regulations that include achieving set learning targets in a learning environment. Parents must be the role models to their children - learners and educators will refine the rough diamonds.

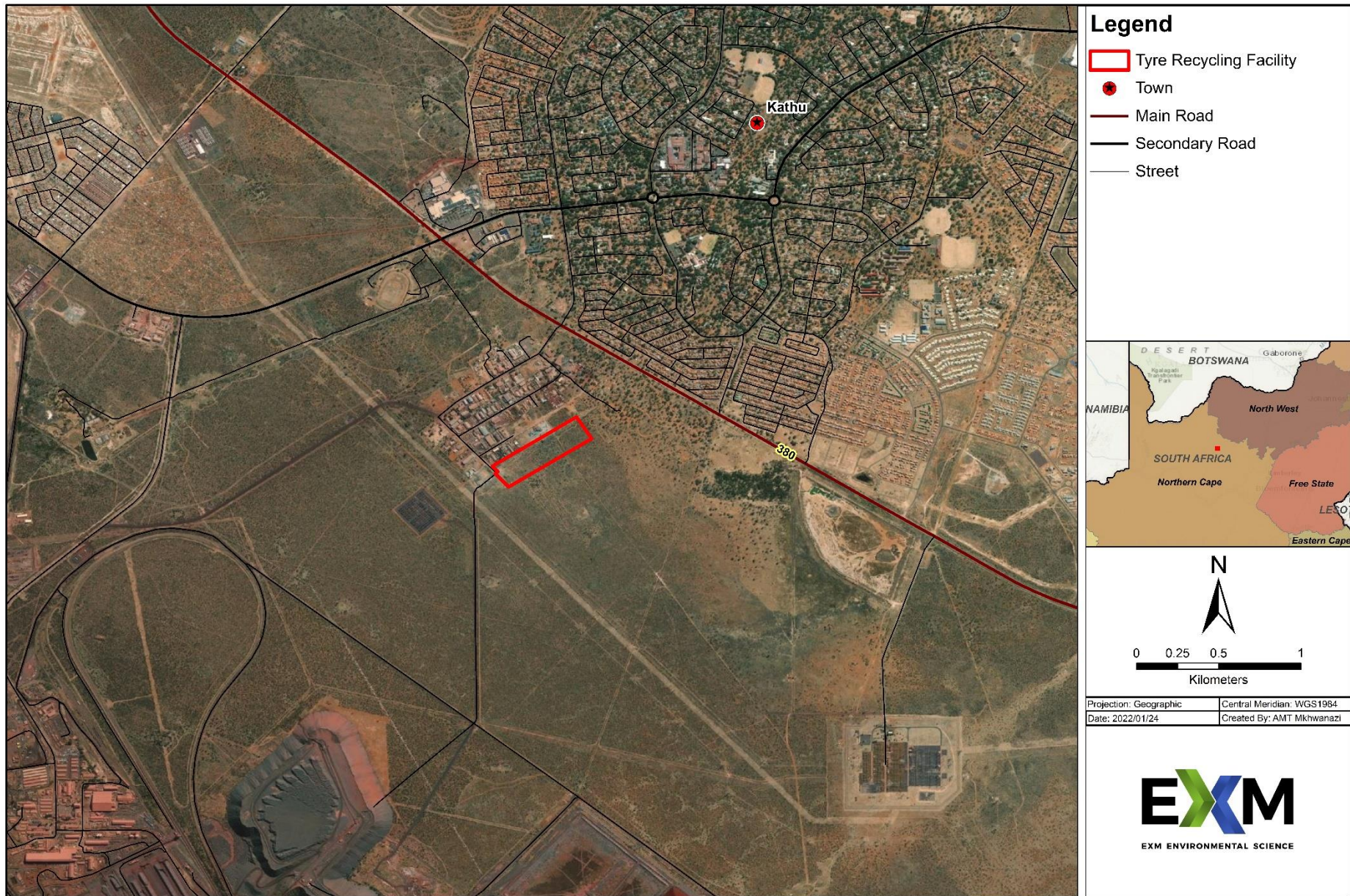

The site is located adjacent (south) to an existing industrial area and the closest residential area is located 460m north-east of the site.

Waste tyres will be transported to the site and downsized to approximately 30-60mm, or even smaller. The product will be transported to offsite facilities for further processing. No further processing (recycling or recovery) of the material will be undertaken and therefore a Waste Management Licence (WML) will not be required for the proposed facility.

The proposed facility including the associated infrastructure will require the clearance of indigenous vegetation of approximately 8.4 hectares and will entail the development of the following structures/infrastructure.

- Building which contains equipment for shredding/cutting of waste tyres;
- Security office;
- Staff building with cafeteria;
- Admin and finance building;
- Diesel storage area (approximately 10m³);
- Waste tyre storage area;

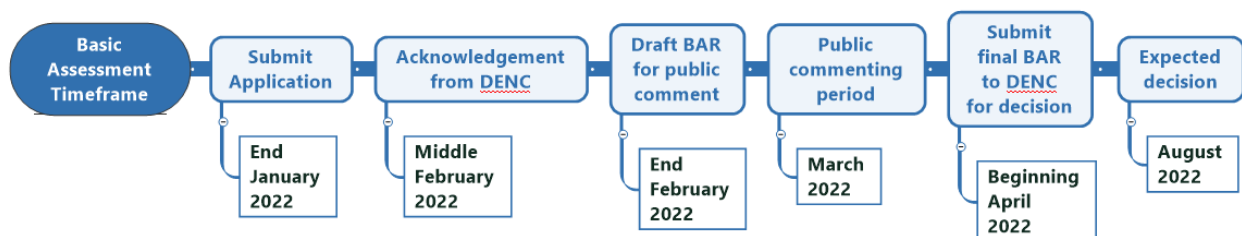


FIGURE 3: BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

3.1.2 National Environmental Management: Waste Act (Act 59 of 2008) (NEM:WA)

In terms of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act (No. 59 of 2008), waste management activities that are listed in regulations (GNR 921) published under NEM:WA may not be undertaken without a Waste Management License (WML) or registration in terms of relevant Norms and Standards. Category A activities require a BA process to be undertaken and Category B activities require a full EIA to obtain a WML prior to commencement. Category C activities must be registered in terms of the relevant Norms and Standards. The proposed facility will trigger the following activities in Category C of GNR 921 and the Table indicates the Norms and Standards applicable to the facility.

3.1.3 National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998) (NWA)

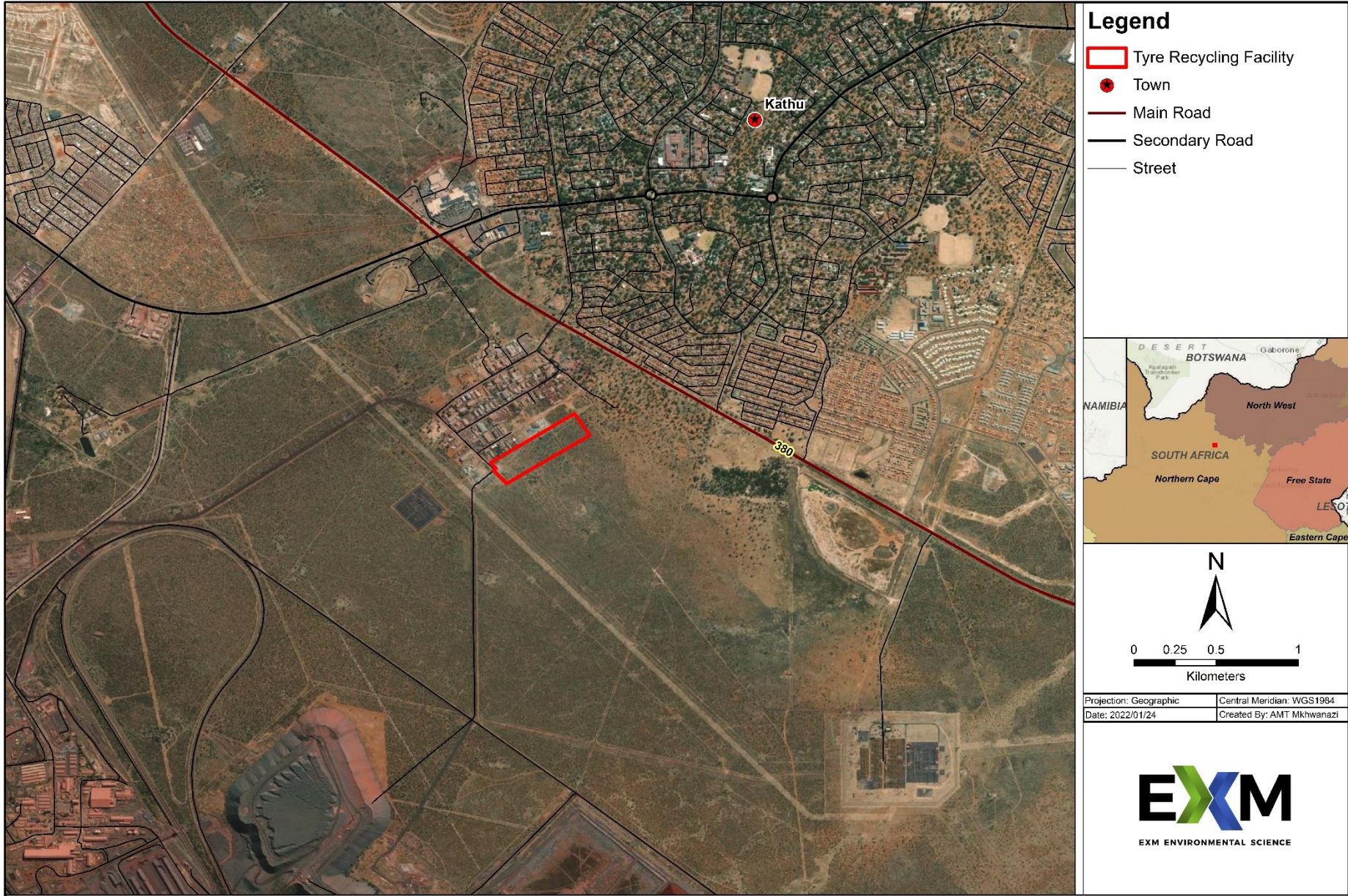

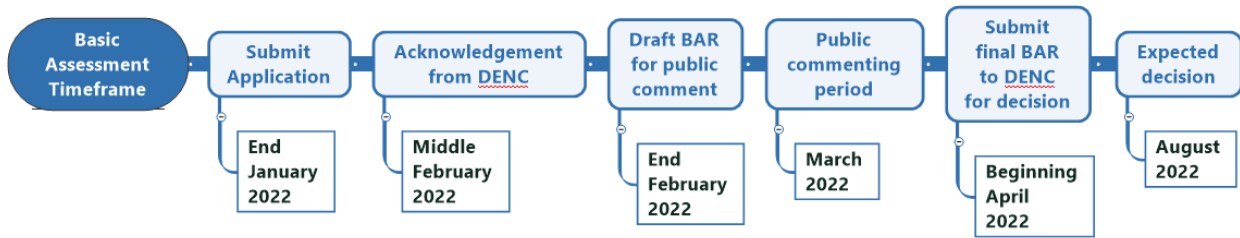

3.2 Wet op Nasionale Omgewingsbestuur: Afval (Wet 59 van 2008) (NEM:WA)

In terme van die Wet op Nasionale Omgewingsbestuur: Afval (No. 59 van 2008) (NEM:WA), mag afvalbestuursaktiwiteite wat in regulasies (GNR 921) gepubliseer is onder NEM:WA nie onderneem word sonder 'n Afvalbestuurslisensie (WML) of gerigistreer word in terme van relevante Norme en Standaarde. Kategorie A aktiwiteite vereis dat 'n Basiese Omgewingsimpakbepaling onderneem word en Kategorie B aktiwiteite vereis 'n Volledige Omgewingsimpakbepaling om sodoende 'n afvalbestuurslisensie te kry voor dat die aktiwiteite begin. Kategorie C aktiwiteite moet gerigstreer word met betrekking tot die relevante Norme en Standaarde. Die voorgestelde fasiliteit sal die volgende aktiwiteite in Kategorie C van GNR 921 behels.

3.3 Nasionale Water Wet (No. 36 van 1998) (NWA)

'n Relatiewe klein vleiland (pan) is ongeveer 320 meter suidwes van die voorgestelde ontwikkeling geïdentifiseer. Volgens GN 509 word alle aktiwiteite binne 500 meter vanaf 'n afgebakende grens (omvang) van enige vleiland of pan gereguleer in terme van Artikel 21 (c) en 21 (i) van die Nasionale Waterwet en vereis magtiging, óf 'n Watergebruiklisensie of 'n Algemene Magtiging afhangende van die riskiko. Volgens die akwatiese spesialis studie wat onderneem is, het die voorgestelde fasiliteit 'n lae risiko om 'n impak op die geïdentifiseerde vleiland uit te oefen en daarom word 'n Algemene Magtiging-aansoek gedoen in lyn met die omgewingsimpakstudie wat onderneem word om magtiging van die Departement van Water en Sanitasie (DWS) te verkry.
