In terms of the 2014 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations published in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act 107 of 1998 (NEMA), the Project Applicant hereby gives notice of its intention to apply for Environmental Authorisation from the **Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD)** as the competent authority, for the proposed Tuna Park Open Space Project in the City of Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality, Nigel, Gauteng.

The Basic Assessment process provided for in Regulation 19 read with Appendix 1 of GN R326 of 4 December 2014 of the 2014 EIA Regulations, as amended published under NEMA will be followed for the application for Environmental Authorisation.

By virtue of location, you have been identified as a potential **Interested and / or Affected Party (I&AP)** to this process, and are hereby invited to participate.

WHAT THIS DOCUMENT TELLS YOU

This Background Information Document (BID), provides you, as a potential I&AP, with **background information** on the proposed project, as well as, information regarding the Basic Assessment (BA) process to be undertaken to assess the potential impacts (i.e. positive and negative, as well as direct, indirect, and cumulative) of the proposed project.

It further indicates how you can participate in the assessment process, receive information and raise issues that may concern and / or interest you. The sharing of information forms an important component of the Public Participation Process as it not only provides I&APs with the opportunity to become actively involved, but also provides information that may be of value for the proposed development.

PROPERTY & PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The affected property consists of natural wetland, public open space, sports fields and sports facilities in Cerutiville and is adjacent to Mackenzieville and Alra Park, situated in Nigel, within the city Ekurhuleni Municipality, Gauteng.

The proposed scope of the project will include the design, development and open space rehabilitation of Tuna Park, Nigel Gauteng. This will include the clean-up and rehabilitation of the wetland and its surrounds, as well as, improving the recreational quality of the park through the development of a community park that will incorporate pedestrian pathways, sports fields and bridges – this will guide the rehabilitation, landscape design and open space optimisation of the existing Tuna Park.

PROJECT MOTIVATION

The motivation and reasoning behind the proposed Tuna Park Open Space Project is for the development of an open space that integrates ecological and social factors providing a safe, accessible and well managed area for the community to utilize in their daily lives. This project will serve to:

- Develop much needed formalized public open space along the watercourse for local community enjoyment.
- Ensure public safety through the formalizing of movement routes, access points and crossings along the watercourse.
- Support and formalize appropriate and compatible existing activities within the open space, including sport and recreation.
- Foster community buy-in and civic pride.

THE BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

NuLeaf Planning and Environmental (Pty) Ltd has been appointed to conduct the Basic Assessment process for the proposed Tuna Park Open Space Project. - An independent **Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP)** must undertake the process on behalf of the applicant to ensure objectivity.
- The first step of the process is to submit an **Application for Environmental Authorisation** to the Competent Authority, which in this case is the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD).
- The EAP must conduct a **Public Participation Process**, and afford any and all persons interested and /or affected by the proposed development an opportunity to register and participate in the process. A **30 day registration period** is allowed for, as well as, an opportunity to ask questions, submit concerns etc.
- The EAP must then prepare a **Draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR)**, inclusive of specialist reports and a draft Environmental Management Programme (EMPr), which describes both the project and the environment and assesses the anticipated impact of the project on the environment, and makes recommendations in terms of mitigation and management.
- Once complete, the Draft BAR will be circulated to all registered I&APs who are entitled to submit written comments in respect thereof. A **30 day comment period** is allowed for in terms of Regulation 40 (1) of the 2014 EIA Regulations.
- Once all comments from registered I&APs have been addressed, the EAP will submit the **Final BAR** to the Competent Authority for consideration.
- The Competent Authority is then required to make a decision on the application for Environmental Authorisation (i.e. either positive or negative).
