Water use license(s) authorisation

The proposed development also, requires a Water Use Licence from the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) in terms of National Water Act No. 36 of 1998 for the following specific water uses:

- Section 21(i): altering the bed, banks, course or characteristics of a watercourse; and
- Section 21(c): impeding or diverting the flow of water in a watercourse

Please note that the application will be submitted to DWS following the authority decision on the development by Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD). Authority consultation with DWS has been initiated. A pre application Water Use Query has been submitted to the relevant authority. A pre-consultation meeting with the authorities will be held in the course of the WUL Application. The DBAR was also submitted to Department of Water affairs and Sanitation for comment.

Heritage permits

Service letters from municipalities

The facility will not require municipal services, however wayleave application may be submitted to the relevant authorities i.e. the water pipelines exist and are just being upgraded within the same servitude, however A servitude is required along the proposed sewer route. The City of Ekurhuleni Municipality's relevant departments will undertake this activity.
