COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT SCOPING REPORT FOR THE PROPOSED 75MW AEP KATHU SOLAR PV ENERGY FACILITY ON THE REMAINDER OF THE FARM 460 LEGOKO, KATHU, WITHIN THE GAMAGARA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY IN THE NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE

The draft Scoping Report (SR) dated January 2016 and received by this Department on 24 February 2016 refers.

This Department has the following comments on the abovementioned application:

- i. Please ensure that all relevant listed activities are applied for, are specific and that it can be linked to the development activity or infrastructure as described in the project description.
- ii. If the activities applied for in the application form differ from those mentioned in the final SR, an amended application form must be submitted. Please note that the Department's application form template has been amended and can be downloaded from the following link <https://www.environment.gov.za/documents/forms>.
- iii. Please ensure that the application form is signed by the applicant and that a signed land owner's notification form is submitted to this Department.
- iv. The final SR must investigate and identify all traffic impacts associated with the proposed development.
- v. Please ensure that all issues raised and comments received during the circulation of the SR from registered I&APs and organs of state which have jurisdiction (including this Department's Biodiversity Section) in respect of the proposed activity are adequately addressed in the Final SR. Proof of correspondence with the various stakeholders must be included in the Final SR. Should you be unable to obtain comments, proof should be submitted to the Department of the attempts that were made to obtain comments. The Public Participation Process must be conducted in terms of Regulation 39, 40 41, 42, 43 & 44 of the EIA Regulations 2014.
- vi. Please provide a description of any identified alternatives for the proposed activity that are feasible and reasonable, including the advantages and disadvantages that the proposed activity or alternatives will have on the environment and on the community that may be affected by the activity as per Appendix 2 of the EIA Regulations, 2014. Alternatively, you should submit written proof of an investigation and motivation if no reasonable or feasible alternatives exist in terms of Appendix 2.
- vii. This Department requires comments from SKA-SA to be included in the final SR.

- viii. Should in-house specialists be used for any specialist study, the specialist study must be peer reviewed by external specialists.
- ix. In terms of Appendix 2 of the EIA Regulations, 2014, the report must include an undertaking under oath or affirmation by the EAP in relation to:
- the correctness of the information provided in the reports;
 - the inclusion of comments and inputs from stakeholders and I&APs;
 - the inclusion of inputs and recommendations from the specialist reports where relevant;
 - any information provided by the EAP to interested and affected parties and
- x. responses by the EAP to comments or inputs made by interested or affected parties
- xi. In accordance with Appendix 2 of the EIA Regulations 2014, the details of—
- (i) *the EAP who prepared the report; and*
 - (ii) *the expertise of the EAP to carry out Scoping and Environmental Impact assessment procedures;*
- must be submitted.
- xii. You are further reminded that the final SR to be submitted to this Department must comply with all the requirements in terms of the scope of assessment and content of Scoping reports in accordance with Appendix 2 and Regulation 21(1) of the EIA Regulations, 2014.

Further note that in terms of Regulation 45 of the EIA Regulations 2014, this application will lapse if the applicant fails to meet any of the timeframes prescribed in terms of these Regulations, unless an extension has been granted in terms of Regulation 3(7).

You are hereby reminded of Section 24F of the National Environmental Management Act, Act No 107 of 1998, as amended, that no activity may commence prior to an environmental authorisation being granted by the Department.

The proposed Overhead Electric Power/Transmission Line is restricted to a maximum of 32m above ground level.

2. We wish to advise that Sentech SOC Ltd ("Sentech") has received an application from AEP Kathu Solar (Pty) Ltd ("the applicant"), which plans to construct one solar PV facility as described in annexure 1 hereto, at the AEP Kathu Solar PV facility, hereafter referred to as "the site", in accordance with the provisions of Section 29(1) (b) of the Electronic Communications Act no. 36 of 2005 ("the Act").
3. 4. Sentech hereby grants the applicant approval to proceed with the construction of its energy project at the site subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - 4.1 Due to the fact that the findings made by Sentech are based on simulations and calculated on a theoretical model, using available data and assumptions where no data was provided, such findings may change at any time should any further information be made available to or come to Sentech's attention;

- 4.2 At any time after the approval, and during construction of the project, should any radio transmissions be affected by construction activities, Sentech will give the applicant 7 (seven) day's written notice to remove the cause of the interference.
- 4.3 Under no circumstances whatsoever will Sentech be liable to the applicant or any third party for any damages, loss or costs, of any nature whatsoever or howsoever arising, suffered as a consequence of the aforementioned request and the applicant fully indemnify Sentech ;

5. This approval is further subject to the submitted applications boundaries or structures listed in annexure 1 hereto, the materials used, as well as the size and positioning of structures declared in the application. If the services of Sentech or its clients is in any way compromised by a deviation or change of this submission, the applicant shall be liable for all costs to re-establish, or relocate the services, and under no circumstances whatsoever will Sentech be liable to the applicant or any other third party for any damages, loss or costs, of any nature whatsoever or howsoever arising, suffered as a consequence.
6. This approval is valid and applicable between Sentech and the applicant only. It does not include any approval for any of the other electronic communication operators which have current co-sharing agreements to utilise Sentech's radio masts.

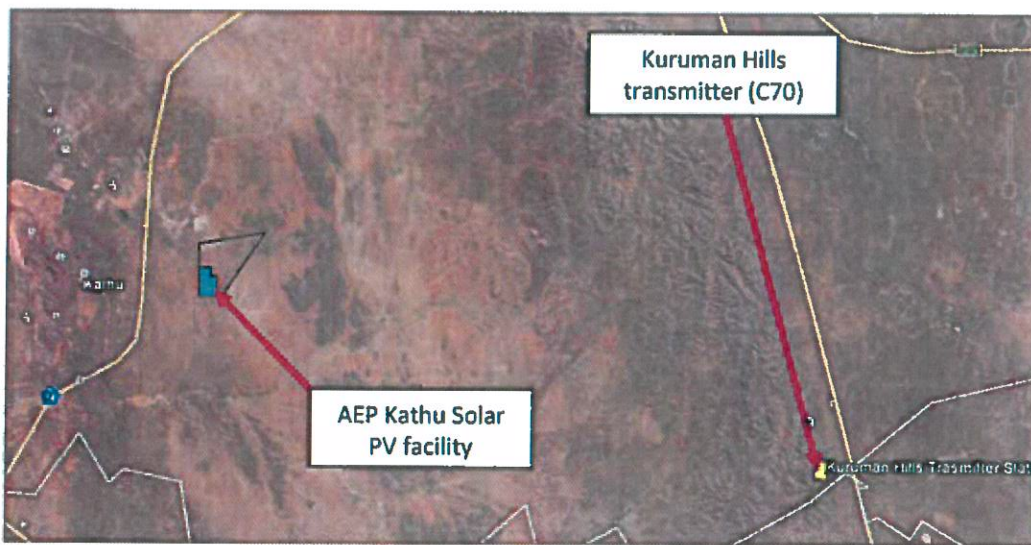

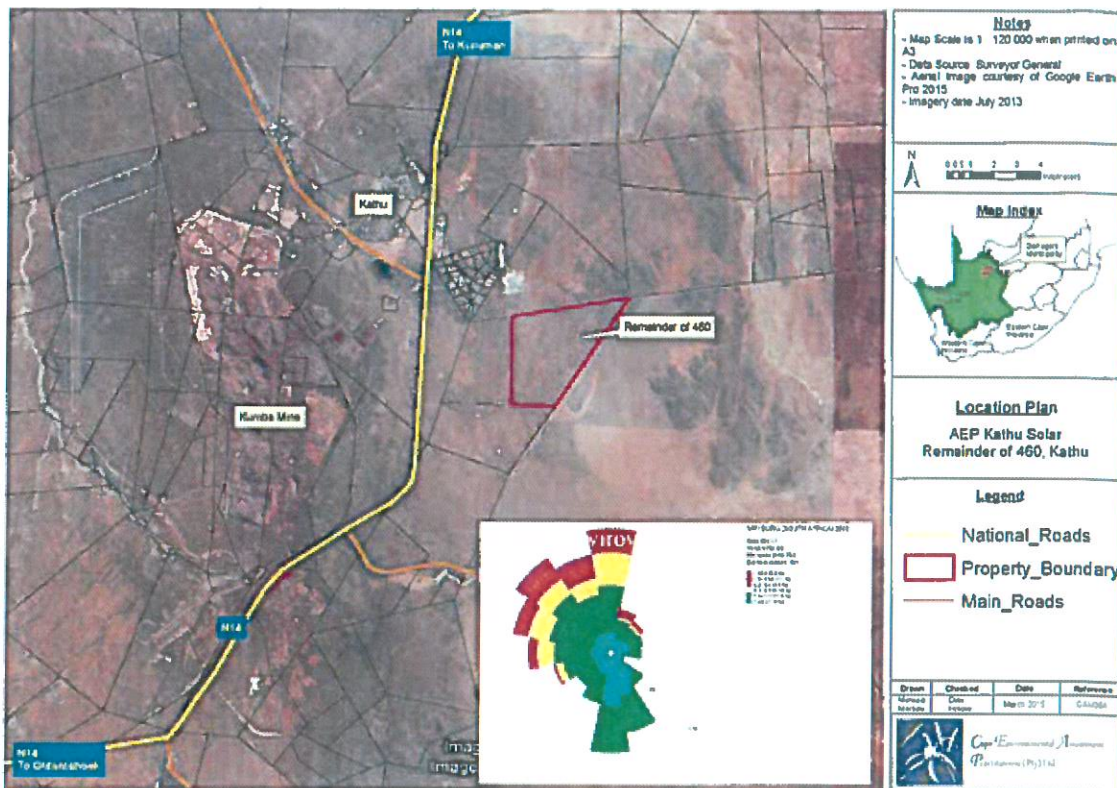
ANNEXURE 1

The planned AEP Kathu Solar PV facility will be located near Kathu according to the developer. The PV facility will be located ± 45 km north-west of Kuruman Hills (C70) transmitter station. The PV facility will be located within the Kuruman Hills (C70) transmitter coverage area. Potential interferences on viewers would be very limited due to the geographical nature of the terrain, very low population density, combined with the distant location of the closest transmitter ± 45 Km (Kuruman).

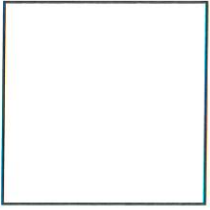
