This Department has the following comments on the abovementioned application:

Contact Details of the Provincial Department in the Application Form

 The Department has noted that the contact details provided in the application form for the Provincial Department of Environment and Nature Conservation (Northern Cape DENC) didn't includes the email address of Mr D van Heerden. Please provide such information as the Department currently use emails for communication with all relevant stakeholders who have jurisdiction to the proposed development.

Activities applied for

- It has been noted that the activities in the application form and the draft SR are not the same. Please ensure
 that all relevant listed activities are applied for, are specific and can be linked to the development activity or
 infrastructure as described in the project description.
- Please ensure that the applied activities are cited correctly as stated in the Listing Notices of EIA Regulations 2014, as amended.
- In addition, it must be elaborated as to whether listed activity 19 on page 12 of the application form will take
 place inside or outside the urban area and its total footprint must be clearly articulated.

Impact Assessment

- A sensitivity layout plan overlaid by the sensitive features and the buffer zones i.e. wetland and also the
 existing structure in the vicinity of the proposed site must be submitted as part of the final report for analysis
 of the effect of the proposed project on the environment. Please ensure all features are clearly indicated on
 the legend of the sensitivity layout plan.
- This Department advise that all relevant specialist studies and impact assessment including cumulative impact assessment to be highlighted in the final SR, in order to adequately address potential impacts of the proposed development in the final ElAr.

Description of identified Alternatives

- Please provide a description of any identified alternatives for the proposed activity that are feasible and reasonable, including the advantages and disadvantages that the proposed activity or alternatives will have on the environment and on the community that may be affected by the activity as per Appendix 2 of GN R.982 of 2014, as amended.
- Alternatively, you should submit written proof of an investigation and motivation if no reasonable or feasible alternatives exist in terms of Appendix 2.

Coordinates

 Please note only the centre coordinates for the proposed substation was include on the draft SR, therefore, you are requested to include corner to corner and centre coordinates in the final SR.

- The Public Participation Process must be conducted in terms of Regulations 39, 40, 41, 42, 43 & 44 of the EIA Regulations 2014, as amended.
