TRAFFIC IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED RETAIL DEVELOPMENT ON THE REMAINDER OF ERF 506 VRYBURG

Your letter K1471/02TIA dated 16 October 2019 and accompanying Traffic Impact Assessment dated September 2019, refers.

The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited hereby concurs with the contents and findings of the above-mentioned assessment, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The proposed NMT-, Public Transport-, and Road upgrades as discussed in sections 8 & 9 of the assessment must be implemented to the specifications of the relevant authority.
- 2. The proposed four-way intersection, from where access will be obtained to the development as well as to the Leon Taljaard Nature Reserve, must be designed and constructed to SANRAL specifications. Provision must be made for sheltered right turn lanes along the N14, as well as bus/taxi stops.

The road reserve boundary on the north western side of the N14 must be replaced in its proper position to eliminate the current wide-open area and to establish a dedicated fourth leg to the intersection that will serve as the access to the nature reserve.

This intersection must be signalised as indicated in the assessment.

- 3. The proposed left in only service access must be designed and constructed to SANRAL's specification in such a way as to discourage illegal traffic movements.
- 4. The existing, priority controlled N14/South street intersection must be signalised as proposed in the assessment.

- 5. The municipality must accept responsibility for the maintenance and operations of the mentioned traffic signals and written proof of such acceptance must be provided to SANRAL for record purpose.
- 6. The signalisation of the intersections mentioned in 2 and 4 above must be accompanied by street lighting to SANRAL's specification. Such street lighting shall be continuous from the south western approach to the N14/South street intersection up to the existing street lighting in town.
- 7. Detailed design drawings for all work to be carried out within the N14 road reserve must be submitted to SANRAL for approval prior to commencement with any such work. No work inside the N14 road reserve will be allowed prior to obtaining SANRAL's written approval.
