Fair's Fair | Skin lightening is about fashion, not inferiority – and it is an issue ripe with hypocrisy, writes **Sede Alonge**

Not all African women believe 'black is beautiful'. And that's OK

TONING. Lightening. Brightening. Whitening. The marketing slogans promoting skin enhancement in Africa might be varied, but the underlying effects are pretty much identical.

Although I do not use skin-lightening products, I live in Nigeria, where millions of women do. On offer are a myriad products designed to make dark skin lighter: kojic acid soaps, fade creams, hydroquinone creams, whitening shower gels made from goat's milk and, for the more determined, skin-lightening injections.

So when popular Kenyan model and socialite Vera Sidika publicly admitted last month to spending tons of money bleaching her skin, she added fuel to an already smoking-hot fire. Just one admission was enough to reignite the fierce debate about Africans' perception of beauty.

Sidika said she was proud of the way she looked and thought African societies were hypocritical about the issue.

Her honesty roused the ire of social media users across the continent.

Passions inevitably run high among Africans whenever someone brings racial issues into play.

On the topic of skin whitening, emotionally charged slogans

such as "black is beautiful" are often employed in an attempt to make women like Sidika feel as if they are somehow betraying their race.


Such women are accused of having inferiority complexes in relation to white people.

In Nigeria – where 77% of women use skin-lightening products, according to the World Health Organisation – the mainstream African commentator, which is mostly male, projects a strong bias against the practice.

I am a dark-skinned Nigerian woman, but I feel that, although there are valid health concerns about the side effects of skin-lightening products, it should remain an individual's prerogative to be who or what they want to be.

Yes, black is beautiful, but so are white, brown, yellow and the many shades in between.

When white people use tanning lotions, solariums and other methods to darken their skin, it is treated as par for the course

to concede this publicly, but the harsh truth is that lighter-skinned girls in Africa do get more attention and are more appreciated than darker-skinned women.

It is not unusual to hear Nigerian men say things such as "Oh, I met this beautiful girl the other day. She had a great body and she was fair in complexion."

But these same men would hypocritically voice outrage if a Nigerian woman, especially one in the public eye, openly admitted to bleaching her skin. If skin tone didn't matter at all to Nigerian men, skin-lightening creams and soaps wouldn't be flying off the shelves here.

In Nigerian music videos, too,

there is a glaring preference for lighter-skinned females. The nagging suspicion remains that my society is more self-deluded about questions of identity and its perception of beauty than it cares to admit.

Physical attraction is instinctive and lighter-skinned women are bound to attract more attention from men in a dark-skinned society such as Nigeria – just like darker-skinned people do in predominantly white societies.

Such interest does not have to be due to any sort of complex and is often simply mere curiosity about difference.

Skin lightening should not be automatically regarded as an

individual's outright rejection of their race. If a woman believes that lightening her skin will make her prettier or more confident, society should let her be and not impose itself as judge and jury of her concept of beauty.

Your skin could cost you your life

Looks can kill when it comes to using skin lighteners, yet many women ignore the warnings, writes **Babalwa Shota**

DYING for beauty. That's what skin lightening really is. The rise of the 'yellow bone' phenomenon – fuelled by social media – has resulted in the resurgence of skin-lightening creams in South Africa.

In the past three years, we've seen South Africans gaping at the impossibly fair-skinned former kwato child star Mshoza flashing a megawatt smile on a magazine cover and waxing lyrical about life as a 'white' woman.

We've been bowled over by a puffy-looking Khanyi Mbau extolling the virtues of skin bleaching as her face peeled to reveal a brighter, pigment-free socialite. Her career took off again and she became a face in demand.

Actress and former beauty queen Sorisha Naidoo even sold her own skin-lightening line after revealing a new, fairer self, bagging herself a multimillionaire and the high life so many dream of.

Finally, skin whitening had moved from downtown streets smack-bang into the celebrity spotlight. It was no longer something to hide, but something to celebrate as a badge of honour.

Just this week, I was left speechless as I followed my friends' Facebook thread singing the praises of a R15 beauty product that they say gets rid of pigmentation marks and leaves the skin so radiant that people will mistake you for Tyra Banks. The discussion about this product by these well-educated, professional black women was so passionate that they completely disregarded the fact that the user was worried about dry, flaking and irritable skin.

Interestingly, not once in their extensive dialogue did they mention the terms "bleaching" and/or "skin whitening". And who am I to ruin their fun by mentioning irritating medical terms such as hydroquinone?

A few weeks ago, I accompanied the police and the health department on a joint raid of downtown Johannesburg stores and vendors to confiscate beauty products that contain the chemical hydroquinone. This was

after I wrote a Sunday Times report on the dangers of skin bleaching, having interviewed many women with disfigured faces, blotchy sores and black burn marks. The following day, I went back to the same stores. The products were all back on the shelves.

The chemical, which is also used as a component in black and white film development, can cause skin sensitivity in mild cases and cancer in severe ones. The sale of over-the-counter skin-bleaching creams containing hydroquinone was banned in South Africa in 1992, but the black market – including spice and cosmetic shops, as well as pavement vendors – still does a brisk business.

That these products are a

health hazard and illegal has not deterred brazen merchants and eager consumers.

That a majority of Africans – men and women – in the age of emancipation still feel that "white" is a far better idea of beauty than "black" boggles the mind. But I get why my fellow sisters will risk cancer and death by using these products – men pay more attention to you when you are fair-skinned, and it's said that your job and promotion prospects look better and life seems to deal you an easier hand.

And, let's face it, being black and a woman is hard enough, so why not take the short cuts when they are offered in a R15 tube?

It's easy to say "black is beautiful" and we should own the skin we live in. But the reality is that many a dark-skinned girl, just like in the movies, will most likely be cast as a sidekick in real life too. So I won't judge a woman who dips into the magic formula to get a few compliments and a promotion. Just as long as she doesn't accuse the rest of us of bewitching her when her face starts melting.

Sukses is moeilik, want 'jy onderhandel met die toekoms'

Hoë beland 'n persoon met 'n doktorsgraad in fisika van die Universiteit van Cambridge in die beleggingswêreld?

Dr. Simon Marais, voorstitter van Allan Gray, meen "fisika is 'n goeie opleidingsagtergrond vir omrent eniglets - dit is baie wiskundig maar meer praktiese".

"In die vroeë 1990's het die banke en finansiële instellings begin agterkom die ouens wat die meeste geld in die markte maak, is die wiskundiges en wetenskaplikes," sê hy.

"Die basiese goed wat nodig is in finansiële dienste is nie baie

moeilik nie - jy moet balansstate en inkomstestate kan lees. Fisika help jou egter om ingewikkeld

stelsels te benader."

Marais se opgang by Allan Gray was verstoormend.

Hy het in 1991 in die IT-afdeling begin, twee jaar later 'n direkteur geword en tien jaar later hoof van beleggings.

In 2002 is hy en sy gesin London toe waar hy hoof van navorsing van Orbis, Allan Gray se internasionale afdeling, geword het.

In 2005 het die Marais-gesin moeg geraak vir die Engelse weer en na Australië verhuis waar hy Allan Gray Australië begin het. Hy besit steeds 50% van dié onderneming. Allan Gray Australië is een van die suksesvolste Australiese fondsbestuurders en bestuur tans sowat R40 miljard na-

mens beleggers.

Hy skryf sy sukses toe aan sy beleggingsstyl: *contrarian*.

"In Goeie tyd om 'n bate te koop, is as al die ander kenners dit verkoop. As jy 'n bate koop, moet jy onthou dat daar 'n ander kenner is wat verkoop, en jy moet weet hoékom. "As als goed gaan, hoe kom gaan iemand teen 'n goeie prys aan jou verkoop?"

Die ideaal is om te koop as daar iets is wat ander beleggers uitskuif, soos swak resultate vir drie of vyf jaar.

Hy sê 'n mens "moet jou nie soveel bekommern oor al die veranderlike nie. Kry daardie twee of drie goed reg wat werklik belangrik is - en wys my dat ek 'n goede prys betaal."

Wat sukses so moeilik maak, is dat jy "onderhandel met die toekoms - niemand weet wat gaan gebeur nie".

Op die vraag hoe Suid-Afrika se kundigheid met die res van die wêreld s'n vergelyk, antwoord

Marais dat "ons altyd dink ouens daar is slimmer, maar dit is nie so nie". Suid-Afrikaners vaar goed in London en in Australië, sê hy. "Die een ding is, ons is meer ondernemend."

Met meer as 20 jaar ervaring beskou Marais Naspers as sy beste belegging nog. Hy het sy eerste huis in die Kaap gekoop deur Naspers-aandele te verkoop. Hy beskou dit "as die duurste huis in die Kaap vandag", aangesien Naspers se prys daarna sowat 30 keer vermengvuldig het!

Hy vertel die staaltjie dat hy op 'n keer met 'n paar tekkees en sy pak klere 'n aanbieding moes doen. Sy bagasie het op 'n vlug soek geraak en "waar kry 'n ou nou 'n nr. 15-skoen (hy is meer as 2 m lank) op kort kenningsgewing?"

Volgens Marais moet jy in elk gevall oppas vir ouens wat te netjes aantrek; hulle het gewoonlik 'n plan. "Is die grootste skelms nie altyd die beste aangetrek nie?"

Obesity, high blood pressure on rise among children

THE prevalence of children being overweight or obese and suffering from high blood pressure is on the rise.

Child, a North West University study now in its fourth year, has tracked children's health as they progress through primary school. "The prevalence of obesity which has a direct link with high blood pressure, is on the increase," said principal investigator Anita Piernaar.

"In 2010, when the children were in Grade 1 and we did the first measurements, we found 12.51 percent were overweight or obese. The prevalence has since risen to 16.71 percent.

"When you consider that a 4.2 percent increase translates into 53 children who were not overweight or obese in Grade 1 but are now in Grade 4, it becomes clear that this is cause for concern."

A total of 571 children from 20 schools in all four districts of the province were participating in the Child study, which looked at health status, physical development and motor development.

"Among children from the most affluent groups, as many as 27 percent were overweight or obese when we tested them in Grade 4 in 2013," said Piernaar. This was in comparison to an obesity rate of only 13 percent among the poorest children.

But even in the most deprived areas, double the number of children had become obese. "It will be interesting to see what the figures look like when we do the next tests in 2016 when we are in Grade 7."

Piernaar told the Cape Times these statistics could not necessarily be translated to a Western Cape context as no coloured children – the largest demographic group in the province – had been tested.

Results of the most recent South African National Health And Nutrition Examination Survey found the heaviest boys and girls were in Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal.

The lightest girls were in Free State and the lightest boys in North West.

Earlier this month, Discovery Vitality released its Healthy Active Kids Report Card 2014. It found less than half of all pupils were active enough; poverty remained a barrier to healthy eating while the consumption of fast food and soft drinks had increased alarmingly.

R400 000 IN DAMAGES AND LOSSES

23 schools hit by burglars

TWENTY-THREE schools have been vandalised or burgled over the winter holidays, a decrease from the same period last year.

Education MEC Debbie Schäfer said schools had been vandalised or burgled despite additional security provided over the holiday period – 45 schools received either 24-hour security or patrols.

"Unfortunately, despite these measures, some of our schools still fall victim to vandalism and burglaries during the school holiday."

Of the affected schools, nine were in the Cape Winelands district, four were in Metro Central, four in Metro South and two from Metro North.

One report of vandalism and burglary was received from each of the remaining districts Eden and Karoo, Overberg, West Coast and Metro East.

"In most cases, perpetrators broke into the school bathrooms and vandalised the interiors. In other cases, computer labs, school offices and classrooms were broken into.

Electronics were stolen and doors and gates damaged

while trying to gain entry."

Schäfer said damage estimates had been received for eight of the 23 schools.

"This amount is estimated to be approximately R400 000 so far. School vandalism not only comes at a cost to the education department, but to that of the pupils and the community too."

She urged communities to take ownership of schools in their neighbourhood by being vigilant throughout the year and reporting suspicious behaviour.

"Our safest schools are normally those in communities that support these

schools, for example, via continuous surveillance and volunteer work."

The Cape Times had reported yesterday on two schools which had been vandalised over the holiday.

In its third incident of vandalism this year, Grassy Park EC Primary had its girls' toilet basins and pipes stolen after vandals accessed the school building through its ceiling.

A computer monitor was stolen from Athwood Primary in Hanover Park and its ceiling damaged in the first incident of vandalism there in about three years.

Faseeg Manie, principal of Lavender Hill Secondary School, which had previously been vandalised, was happy to report there had been no break-ins there.

A section of the school's fence had been stolen during the April holiday and a new bullet-reflective fence had been installed.

"It is really making our school very safe and secure especially in the heart of gangland."

Cableway to close for facelift

Table Mountain Cableway will be closed from Monday until Sunday, August 10 for maintenance. Table Mountain Air Company marketing manager Colette van Aswegen said plans included cleaning and testing slack rope, renewing switches and bearings, servicing the main gearbox, generators and back-up generators, as well as general maintenance and testing.

There would also be building painting and road painting for the new MyCiTi Bus route to the Lower Cableway Station.

Maintenance was required "to meet the highest global cableway standards set by the Swiss governing body for cableways", said Van Aswegen.

Financial planner on fraud rap

A former Nedbank financial planner Andrew Charles van Reenen, 46, accused of stealing more than R1.47 million from four clients over three years, has appeared briefly in the Bellville Specialised Commercial Crime Court.

He has been charged with fraud, theft and money laundering. Simon Leope, for the State, said he had given Van Reenen's defence particulars for the case.

The court granted a postponement until August 26, so the defence could draft its representations.

New witness called by State in trial of fugitive Krejcir

A new State witness was called in the trial of Czech fugitive Radovan Krejcir and five others in the South Gauteng High Court in Johannesburg, sitting in Palm Ridge, yesterday.

The witness, Bhezikizitha Khumalo, worked with Doctor, brother of the man whose kidnapping Krejcir is alleged to have ordered.

Khumalo told of his dealings with Doctor, who reportedly had disappeared with 25kg of tik (methamphetamine) he had been tasked with transporting to Australia, allegedly for Krejcir. Doctor worked for a cargo company at OR Tambo International Airport.

Krejcir, Desai Luphondo, Warrant Officers Samuel "Saddam" Maropeng and George Nthoroane, Jan Lefu Mofokeng, and Siboniso Miya face charges of kidnapping, attempted murder, and dealing in drugs.

'Headache gang' to appear again

Two men, allegedly linked to various robberies at local filling station shops, will again appear in the Bloemfontein Magistrate's Court Volksblad newspaper reported yesterday.

The men and a woman, locally dubbed the "Sweet tooth and headache" gang because of their preference for chocolates and Grand-Pa headache powder, were arrested last week after allegedly terrorising filling stations for the past six months.

The men appeared in court on charges of theft on Monday. The matter was postponed to next Tuesday.

The men were arrested in Bloemfontein on Thursday. The woman was arrested in Kimberley last week.

Various Bloemfontein filling station owners appointed a private investigator to catch them.

Protesters demand safety for health workers

ABOUT 200 people gathered yesterday to protest against the lack of security for doctors and other health care workers in Khayelitsha.

The protest, organised by the Treatment Action Campaign (TAC), was triggered by the death of Michael Aluko, an obstetrician working at the Khayelitsha Hospital and Khayelitsha Health Centre in Site B.

Originally from Nigeria, Aluko was on night duty last month at the Site B Day Hospital when he went to buy food at a nearby garage.

He was hijacked there and shot twice. His body was left in the Macassar cemetery.

"He was always pleasant to work with and quite interactive with his patients," said Dr Adenoe Abeni, a close friend. "People liked to work with him, he had a full heart."

Protesters gathered in memory of Aluko outside the Khayelitsha Magistrate's Court holding white signs with red and black words reading: "Justice must prevail".

After an address by Fanie Fontein, a family physician at the Khayelitsha Hospital, about the safety concerns of Khayelitsha doctors, the pro-

testers delivered a memorandum to Yayi Velile, the court manager, which stated: "Doctors are an essential human resource in providing quality health care to all in our communities. Communities have a responsibility to ensure doctors are safe and protected."

The memorandum said the murder of health professionals in Khayelitsha could discourage potential applicants from applying for vacant physician posts in the area.

"Staff members were held at gun and knife point in Khayelitsha just near the court a few weeks after Michael was killed," Fontein said. "Staff

are still not feeling safe." Fontein hoped the protest would result in higher police visibility "such as police vehicles in high risk areas and during hospital shift changes."

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) was also present to urge increased safety at hospitals and clinics in the area. Though no MSF staff have been killed, Iain Watermeyer of MSF said the violence had affected their work environment. "We have to make sure when we get to work that everyone is accounted for. Many of our staff also work in Khayelitsha, so their safety is always a concern."

Protesters also had con-

cerns over the way the police responded to Aluko's murder.

Ntomboxolo Mue of TAC accused the police of dragging their feet.

The demands listed in the memorandum include regular communications between the courts and victims' families, more effective communication between investigating officers and prosecutors, and that Khayelitsha residents be served by magistrates and prosecutors who understand the living and crime conditions in Khayelitsha.

Police had not commented by the time of going to press.

McGregor dedicated his life to community

PHILANTHROPIST James McGregor, chairman of the Cape Towns Bursary Fund, has died after a long illness at the age of 69.

Cape Town born and bred, he served on at least 20 non-profit organisations, often as chairman, and last year he won the Inayathelo Philanthropy Award for his wide range of charitable activities.

These included chairing the Westlake United Churches Trust aimed at uplifting and empowering the Westlake Village community with educational, health and employment projects; the Leliebloem House care and residential centre in Athlone for 84 children in need of intervention; the Molteno Brothers' Trust and Foundation which furthers literacy and community upliftment, among other aims; and the LEAP maths and science schools board, which provides secondary school opportunities for disadvantaged youngsters.

McGregor also served as a trustee of the ASSET Educational Trust, whose development programme for pupils from disadvantaged communities produced candidates for the Cape Towns Bursary Fund.

He was involved with the Progressive Federal Party and its antecedents for many years, and was chairman of the Wynberg

branch of the party.

James Alexander Corbet McGregor was born in Tokai, matriculated at Bishops, graduated at UCT, and worked for the Board of Executors in Cape Town for 24 years.

He became the company's financial director in 1994 before retiring six years later.

He retained strong links with his old school, and served as chairman of the Diocesan School Council and vice-president of the Old Diocesans' Union.

McGregor was also a founding trustee of the Bishop Dikeni Empowerment Trust.

His religious faith led him to do much work for the Anglican Church, which he served in various capacities including membership of the Cape Town diocese's strategic planning task team in 2000/01.

McGregor's funeral service will take place in the Bishops Memorial Chapel on Wednesday, July 30, at 3pm.

Mushrooms 'trained' for bittersweet mission

NEW YORK: An upstart US food technology company has developed a unique fermentation process using mushrooms to reduce bitterness in cocoa beans that it believes will cut sugar content in chocolate bars.

A year after first launching its fermentation method to reduce bitterness in coffee beans, one of the world's biggest commodity markets,

Mycotechnology Inc, is expanding into cocoa and was to launch its process yesterday.

The market is smaller, but the potential may be bigger with health-conscious consumers seeking lower-calorie foods amid mounting concerns about obesity and diabetes.

"We use mushrooms that we train specifically to remove unwanted aspects of food and infuse it with the natural health benefits of the mushroom," said Alan Hahn, chief executive of MycoTechnology Inc, formed in 2013 in Denver, Colorado.

About half of the average milk chocolate bar is made of sugar, according to industry experts. MycoTechnology can cut the amount of sugar needed in the average chocolate bar by half, from 31 grams to about 15 grams.



Banks part of urgent R699 car hearing

The hearing looking into the R699 car sales scheme has been set for early August in the Eastern Cape High Court in Port Elizabeth, a lawyer representing consumers said on Tuesday 22 July.

The hearing opens up the possibility that class action could be taken against the banks that supported the scheme, which was launched in 2008 by Andre Venter, the CEO of the Satinsky Group.

A group of apparently 550 consumers, led by Port Elizabeth lawyer Duncan Heuer of Pieterse Cary Finlaison, is to ask the court to declare contracts between the banks and car buyers null and void.

In court papers the respondents are listed as the Satinsky Group, along with Standard Bank, Absa, and Nedbank's Motor Finance Corporation.

FirstRand's Wesbank is also listed, but it is most likely they will appear only as a witness, since they rejected participation in the scheme in 2011.

About 17 000 people are believed to have been affected by the scheme, which offered to cut repayments on new cars to about R699, if the motorists drove a minimum distance with pasted advertisements about the scheme on their cars.

The scheme collapsed earlier this month with banks now calling

for full repayments.

Heuer told the newspaper that he believed the R699 scheme resembled a Ponzi model.

Venter has apparently opened up another company that offers unusual motor financing structures.

Weslander's readers also showed anger towards the scheme and sympathy towards the consumers embroiled in the controversy.

"Always thought it was too good to be true!" Nikki Bodenstein wrote on Weslander's Facebook page.

"I feel so sorry for people that bought vehicles with this scheme," said Charlene van Vuuren, also on Weslander's Facebook.

Brandstof gaan sakke moontlik meer knyp

Die Outomobiel-assosiasi (AA) het Dinsdag 15 Julie aangekondig dat die brandstofprys teen die einde van die maand met 26c per liter kan styg.

Dit volg na die brandstofprys vroeër vandeesdaan met 29c gestyg het.

"Daar is sedert begin Julie 'n stadige maar bestendige opswaai in die wisselkoers tussen die rand en die dollar," het die AA in 'n verklaring aan Sapa gesê.

"In dieselfde tydperk het internasionale petroleumprys se hoogtepunte in middel Junie gedaal, maar nie genoeg om die onderverhaling in die petrolprys te verreken nie. As internasionale petroleumprys steeds afwaarts

neig, gaan die wisselkoers die hoofaktor wees."

Diesel-verbruikers kan egter bietjie beter voel.

Daar word 'n effense styging van sowat 3c per liter, deur huidige data voorspel, het die AA gesê.

Die AA het ook gesê dat spoedige oplossings vir die huidige arbeidsgeskille in die land baie belangrik is, omdat dit ook die brandstofprys negatief kan beïnvloed.

Verbruikers kan maar weer stadigaan begin dink aan maniere hoe omdie laaste paar druppels uit die petroltenk te tap.

Hier volg 'n paar wenke van die AA oor hoe om brandstof te bespaar:

1. Hou jou wiele se banddruk dop. Bande wat net 'n bietjie te pap is kan jou brandstofverbruik met tot 3,3% laat styg omdat jou enjin harder moet werk wanmeer jy briek trap.

2. Vat jou motor gereeld vir 'n diens. 'n Voertuig wat nie goed onderhou word nie sal nie optree soos hy ontwerp is om op te tree nie. Dit beteken jou enjin sal harder werk en sodoende meer brandstof verbruik.

3. Sit af jou lugverkoeler. 'n Lugverkoeler gebruik 'n pomp wat deur jou enjin aangedryf word. Dit veroorsaak dat jou enjin harder werk en meer brandstof gebruik. *Bronne: Huisgenoot, AA.
