COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT SCOPING REPORT AND PLAN OF STUDY FOR THE PROPOSED EXPLORATION WELL DRILLING PROGRAMME IN THE ORANGE BASIN DEEP WATER LICENSE AREA OFF THE WEST COAST OF SOUTH AFRICA (DEA REF. NO 14/12/16/3/3/2/704).

Correspondence with respect to the aforementioned application dated 09 October 2013 and received by this Directorate on 10 October 2013, this Directorate's correspondence dated 31 October 2013 and the draft Scoping Report (dated July 2014) together with your correspondence dated and received by this Directorate on 23 July 2014, refer.

1. According to the information provided, this Directorate notes the following:

- 1.1. The proposed development entails the establishment of one or two exploration wells in the northern portion of the Orange Basin Deep Water licence area;
- 1.2. The depth of each well will range between 2700m and 3000m below the sea floor; and
- 1.3. An onshore facility will be required for storage purposes.

2. The following comments are related to the draft Scoping Report ("SR"):

2.1. The applicable listed activities:

- 2.1.1. Please note that when the activity description of the proposed development is refined and finalised, only the applicable listed activities must be indicated in the Environmental Impact Assessment Report ("EIAR");
- 2.1.2. Should the proposed activity require an Air Emissions Licence ("AEL") in terms of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act, 2004 (Act No. 39 of 2004), the applicable listed activity must be applied for. The relevant specialist terms of reference must be included in the Plan of Study for Environmental Impact Assessment prior to the submission of the final SR should an AEL be required;

- 2.2. Given that the drill cuttings generally remain on the sea bed, alternative methods of disposing the drill cuttings must be reported on in the EIAR;
- 2.3. A detailed description (including the location) of the proposed 'onshore logistics base' must be provided; and
- 2.4. The potential impacts of the dissolving cement must be identified, assessed and reported on in the EIAR.

You are required to quote the abovementioned reference number in any future correspondence in respect of the application.

This Directorate reserves the right to revise or withdraw comments or request further information based on any information received.
