2. Motivation for proposed work (Please motivate fully)

Tendele coal mine, hereafter referred to as the mine, has the mining rights for this land (KZN 30/5/1/2/2/216 MR) in which mining activities is currently occurring. All the homesteads and families on this land, have been relocated (with contracts and compensation) due the current mining activities on this land.

The Next of kin (NoK) of these graves has been located and is asking their deceased family members to be relocated to the Northdale Cemetery in Mtubatuba and not left within the mining area. Additionally, with the graves relocated to the Northdale Cemetery in Mtubatuba they do not run the risk of being disturbed in any way, especially towards the future mining of this area, which is in the direction of the graves. The family members wishing to visit the graves are now subdued to fill in registers and escorted to the graves which is not very intimate. The family members visitation of the deceased, in the mining area, is a high risk for both the family members and the mine. Thus is it in the best interest of all affected for these graves to be relocated.

3. Detail of the proposed work:

- Arrange for a suitable date with the NOK, SAPS, client and district health inspectors;
- Fully document the grave dressing (photographs, measurements and description of the grave);
- Scaled drawings of the cemetery/graves. The position of the graves will also be recorded by the mine's survey department;
- Once the grave has been documented, the dressing/headstones will be removed to expose the grave pit;
- Opening of the grave and exhumation of the remains. The methods employed during exhumation aim to recover all the remains, to minimise damage to the remains and to preserve and respect the dignity of the buried individual. The excavation and exhumation methods usually employed accomplish the in situ exposure of the human remains and associated artefacts. The need for adequate workspace around the exposed remains and a systematic approach to the removal of individual bones is imperative in this regard;
- The excavation of the remains will be done under the supervision of an ASAPA accredited archaeologist and a registered undertaker. All excavations will be done by hand by experienced and skilled technicians;
- After exhumation, the human remains will be handed over to the undertaker for reburial in the cemetery of the next-of-kin's preference. It must be noted that once exhumed, the remains will only be handled by the undertaker as per health regulations;
- Once exhumed, the remains will be reburied in the following locations as per the next-of-kin's wishes:

o The Nshali family (KQ/GR/04 to 10) will be reburied at the Northdale Cemetery in Mtubatuba

The arrangements for the reburial will be made by the undertaker (North Coast Funerals) in consultation with the next-of-kin.
