1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 BACKGROUND

The Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) appointed BKS (Pty) Ltd to conduct a Basic Assessment (BA). The basic assessment process, will be conducted as stipulated in the environmental impact assessment (EIA) regulations (2010) made under Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) as part of a waste license application. The proposed project is classified as, and will be conducted – in terms of a Category A waste management activity in accordance with Section 20(b) of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act. No. 59 of 2008).

During the PPP for the proposed project, potential Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) were invited to participate in the process. The comments received, and issues raised during this PPP are integrated into the Basic Assessment Report (BAR), and are used to assist the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to anticipate impacts and develop mitigation measures for the proposed project.

1.2 AIM OF THE REPORT

The aim of this report is to:

- describe the PPP conducted;
- present the register of registered I&APs;
- provide a list of issues raised to date; and
- outline the way forward.

The report presents the findings of the process, summarises the main concerns and issues that were raised and presents a way forward to address the issues raised.

2. THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

Public participation provides the opportunity for I&APs to participate on an informed basis and to ensure that their needs and requirements are considered. In so doing, ownership of the project is vested in both the project Applicant and the community.

A PPP should achieve the following:

- provide a "vehicle" for public input and the facilitation of negotiated outcomes;
- create trust and partnerships;
- minimise negative impacts and maximise positive impacts; and
- provide an up-front indication of issues which may have an impact on the BA process.

2.1 APPROACH

The approach towards any PPP is dependent upon the details of the project. Each project has a particular geographic and technical nature and hence the PPP should be structured accordingly. Where possible and within the required statutory frameworks, it is also desirable to structure such a process to address the needs of I&APs.

2.2 METHODOLOGY

The following methods were used during the process:

2.2.1 IDENTIFICATION AND REGISTRATION OF I&APs

Through networking and advertising, **80** I&APs are currently registered on the public participation database for the proposed closure licence application. BKS has made an effort to ensure that individuals or organisations from an institutional as well as from a geographical point of view were identified.

Geographically, BKS focused on nearby or adjacent landowners, communities and structures that represent the local community. Institutionally the focus is on those organisations or individuals that may influence policies and decisions or make a contribution to the project. Not all of these organisations are necessarily in the project's direct sphere of impact.

2.2.2 CREATING AWARENESS DURING THE BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

A variety of mechanisms were used to create awareness of the proposed project amongst those that may be directly or indirectly affected.

a) Media

The newspaper advertisement notifying the public about the mini-transfer station that was originally proposed, appeared in the following newspaper:

- The Rustenburg Herald on the 02 February 2012.

The newspaper advertisement gave I&APs a chance to register as I&APs for the proposed development.

b) On-site Notices

Six (6) A2 sized site notices were placed in the project area on the 04 February 2010 to announce the proposed project.

2.2.3 DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION

Information was disseminated to registered I&APs primarily by means of a Background Information Document (BID) and notification letter.

a) Background Information Document

A BID provides background information on the proposed project, the processes to be followed and the appropriate contact information. This document was distributed to the I&APs on 02 February 2012.

b) Notification Letter

A notification letter was sent to registered I&APs on the 02 February 2012 to announce the start of the proposed project.

c) Contact Details

The BKS contact details were provided on all written communication to ensure interaction from I&APs.

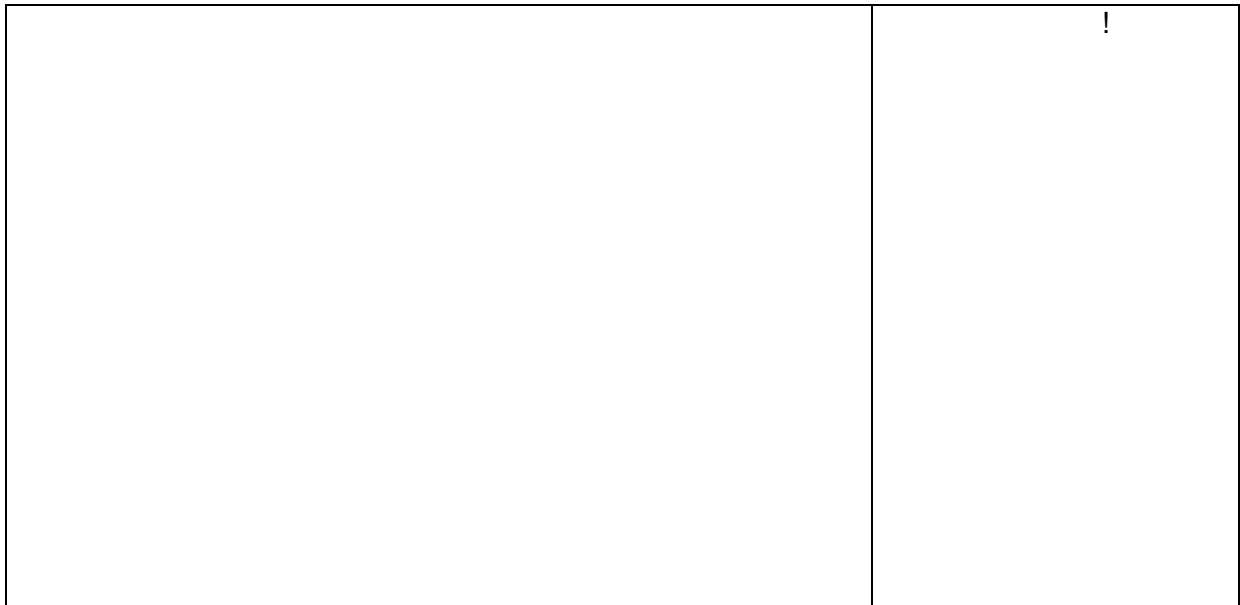

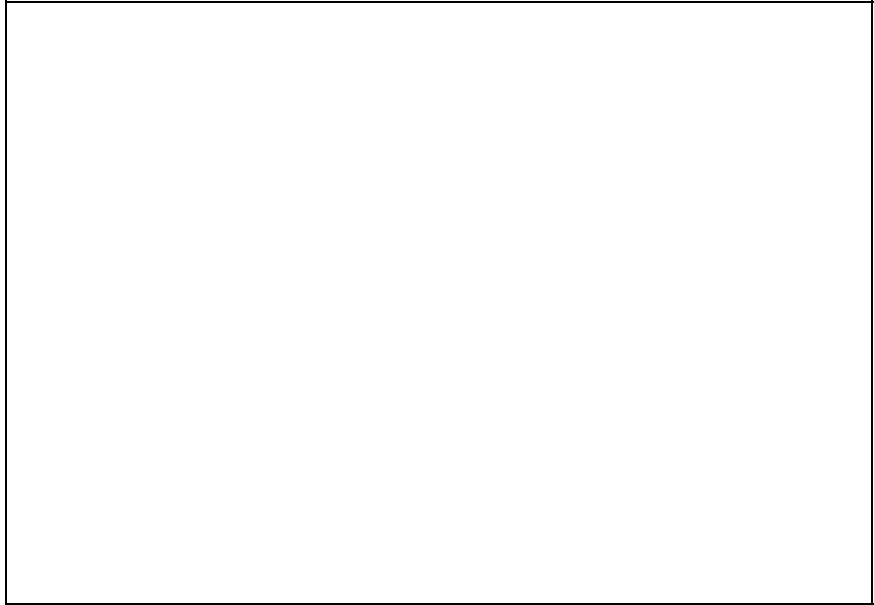
