You are hereby notified that the Final Scoping Report has been accepted by the Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (DEDET). The DEDET has requested that Janet Edmonds Consulting cc. (JEC) proceed with the Assessment Phase of the Process.


The EIA Phase is currently underway and comprises a number of Specialist Studies, including the following:

- Water Quality Assessment;
- Wetland / Drainage Line Delineation;
- Geotechnical Assessment; and
- Heritage Impact Assessment.

The findings of the Specialist Studies will be presented at a Public Information Session and in the Draft EIA Report and Environmental Management Programme (EMPr). All registered IAPs will be informed of the date and time of the Public Information Session, as well as the availability of the Draft EIA Report and EMPr, as and when these become available. All IAPs will be afforded the opportunity to comment on the Draft EIA Report and EMPr. These comments will be incorporated into the Final EIA Report, responded to and submitted to the DEDET for a decision in terms of granting or denying Environmental Authorisation.
