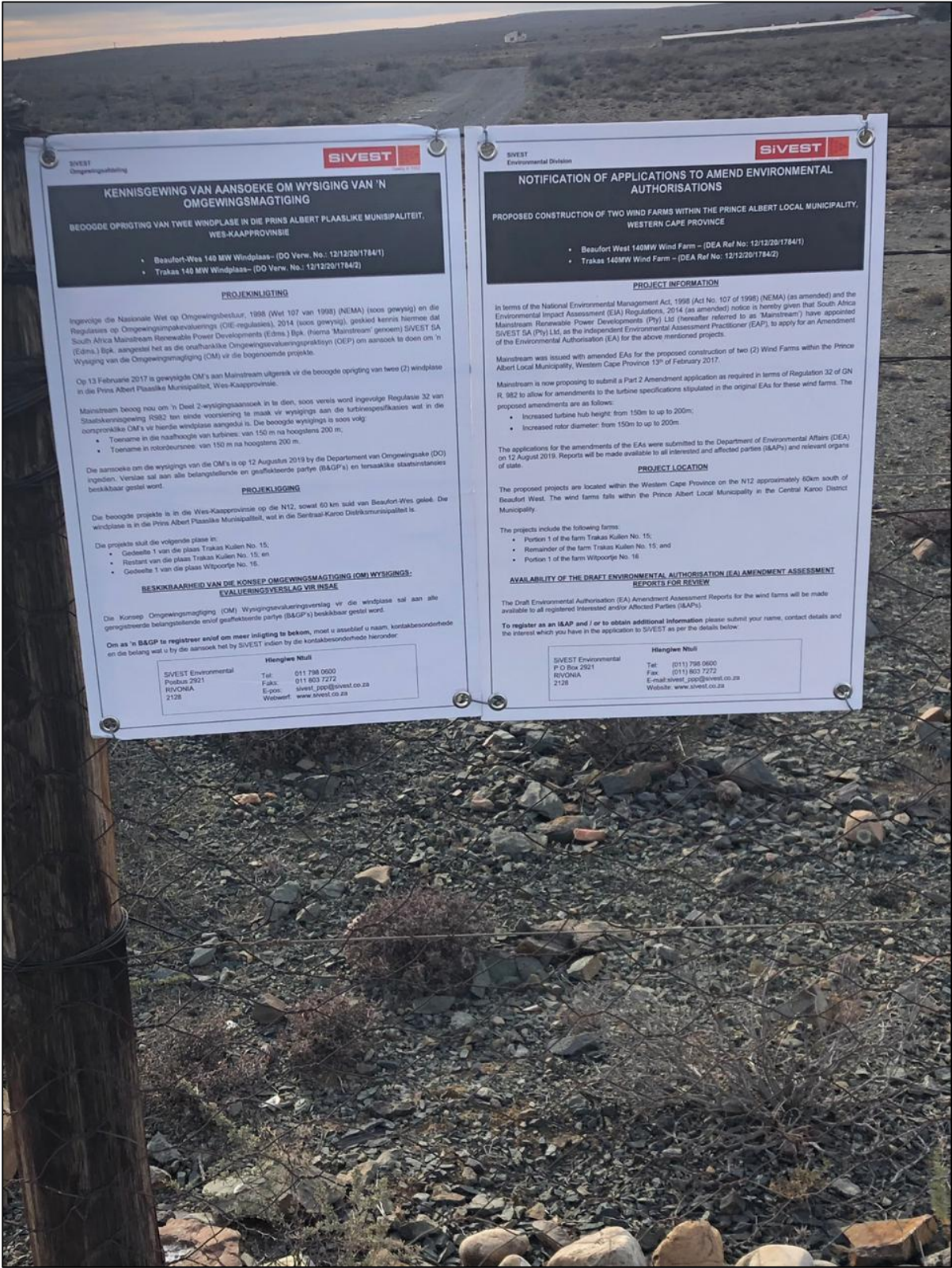

PROJEKINLIJTING

Ingevolge die Nasionale Wet op Omgewingsake, 1998 (Wet 107 van 1998) (NEMA) (soos gewysig) en die Regulasies op Omgewingsakevalkerings (OIE-regulasies), 2014 (soos gewysig), geskied kennis hiermee dat South Africa Mainstream Renewable Power Developments (Edms.) Bpk. (hierna "Mainstream") geneem SIVEST SA (Edms.) 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Eden Karoo pupils head to Eskom Expo International Science Fair

Eight pupils have been selected to represent the Eden Karoo region at the Eskom Expo International Science Fair (ISF) competition in Boksburg, Gauteng from 24 to 27 September 2019.

At this prestigious event, pupils stand a chance to win various prizes and bursaries with a total value of R5 million and a scholarship to Germany sponsored by Siemens with a value of R1 million. Pupils also stand a chance to be selected to embark on a much sought after international tour ranging from America, Asia, Europe and the rest of Africa.

Bontle Mlokoti, Siviwe Ngqambuza, Kuyler Geldenhuys, Phillip van der Merwe, Sinokuhle Rungqu, Megan Bailey, Anne-Maria Andreani and Lunje Mengezeleli will be representing the Eden Karoo region at the ISF.

The pupils had been selected following the fifth ever Eskom Expo for Young Scientists in the Eden Karoo region, which grew by almost 55% in the last year.

The regional final was held at the George Town Hall and featured seven new participating schools. A total of 141 learners from the region showcased their innovative science and engineering investigations, while 29 judges who are educators, subject specialists, university students and Eskom Expo enthusiasts assessed the 86 projects that were on exhibition.

This year, the most number of entries were seen in the engineering category with 17 entries. There were also a significant number of entries in the environmental studies and energy categories, according to Eden Karoo regional science fair director, Caroline Bredell, who is a former engineer and is passionate about involving more young women in science.

"Sometimes pupils need to push past the noise and put their focus where it matters. I believe that Eskom Expo for Young Scientists creates a good opportunity for this," said Bredell.

- Most innovative project: Phillip van der Merwe (Grade 9 at Outeniqua High School)

At the awards ceremony following the expo, a total of 32 pupils received bronze medals, 19 received silver and 13 received gold. Pupils from Outeniqua High School received the most number of gold medals, and medals overall.

Eskom Expo Executive Director, Parthy Chetty, says, "Now in its 40th year of existence, Eskom Expo continues to provide a unique platform for the thousands of bright young minds in our country, to showcase their talent, which would otherwise, have been lost in the system.
