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INTRODUCTION

Brava Engineers appointed Hanslab (Pty) Ltd. (hereafter referred to as Hanslab) on behalf of the KZN Department of Transport (DoT) to undertake the Basic Assessment Application process for the proposed development of a 3km long sidewalk adjacent to Main Road P237 (right-hand side only) towards the area of St Lucia.

1. PURPOSE OF THE BID

This Background Information Document (BID) provides stakeholders and Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) with information on the proposed project and details regarding the Basic Assessment (BA) being undertaken by Hanslab (Pty) Ltd. It also aims to emphasise the importance of public participation during the assessment phase and allows for input from Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) on the potential issues that may arise. The BID provides I&APs with an opportunity to register as stakeholders in this process and encourages response to documents distributed for public review.

2. NEEDS AND DESIRABILITY

The P237 Sidewalk will serve as daily access for the community of Dukuduku and St. Lucia to access the beach and places of work. Furthermore, sidewalk extension will reduce risks to local people not using any mode of Transport as the area experiences high traffic during holiday seasons. The extension of P237 St. Lucia sidewalk will introduce access to several amenities that form the basis of socio-economic stability and create an upward economic trajectory in development.

3. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The client proposes to extend the footprint of an existing sidewalk by 3km in length, the width will be 3m.It is noted that P237 Road is the local road that serves as an access for the community of Dukuduku to St. Lucia.. No new roads will be constructed, the proposed project scope only includes the extension of the sidewalk. The proposed development consists of constructing a



concrete slab sidewalk and associated stormwater infrastructure along the P237 road with a linear footprint of 0.9ha.

The P237 Sidewalk will serve as daily access for the community of Dukuduku and St. Lucia to access the beach and places of work. The sidewalk extension will reduce risks to local people travelling on foot as the area gets high traffic during the holiday season.

According to SANBI's GIA Datasets and the uMkhanyakude EDTEA, a portion of the proposed P237 Sidewalk is situated within iSimangaliso Wetland Park. From a desktop assessment, the entire area seems to be a wetland. In terms of vegetation, the areafalls under Maputaland Coastal Belt. Cutting and pruning of some large trees is anticipated to occur as trees were identified to be falling within the proposed development footprint.

4. PROJECT LOCALITY

The proposed P237 sidewalk extension will start from the iSimangaliso (Dukuduku Gate) turn-off from P237 and end at Lake St Lucia. is The proposed development area is situated approximately 25km east of N2 Highway.




Figure 1: Map showing the location of P237 Sidewalk extension (Source: ArcGIS)
