PURPOSE OF BID

The purpose of this Background Information Document (BID) is to provide the following information regarding the Atmospheric Emission License (AEL) application to relevant organs of state, interested persons and the public:

- The nature and purpose of the license being applied for;
- Particulars of the listed activities;
- Location of the Venetia Mine and the location where the listed activities are carried out; and
- Providing a reasonable period within which written representation on or objections to the application may be submitted.

NATURE AND PURPOSE OF LICENSE

The National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act, 2004 (Act No. 39 of 2004) and National Environmental Management: Air Quality Amendment Act, 2014 (Act No. 20 of 2014) (NEM:AQA) were developed to reflect the overarching principles within the Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA), as amended, to meet the terms of general environmental policies and to bring legislation in line with both local and international good air quality management practices, with the aim to update and improve air quality legislation in South Africa.

Processes published in Government Gazette (GG) No. 37054, General Notice (GN) 893, dated 22 November 2013 require licensing in terms of Section 22 of NEM: AQA.

LISTED ACTIVITY

The following is a brief description of activities at Venetia Mine found to draw a parallel with activities categorised in part 3 of GN893 that require licensing as per Section 22 of NEM: AQA:

 Venetia Mine's red area incinerator has a design capacity of 330 General Refuse Equivalent (G.R.E) units per hour. The design capacity of the red area incinerator exceeds the permissible treatment rate, of at least 10kg per day of general and hazardous waste, set out in sub category 8.1 of this notice and therefore requires licensing;

- The small incinerator, located at the sewage treatment plant, is operated once a week to incinerate approximately 1.6kg of waste consisting of rags, plastics, paper and sanitary waste. The small incinerator's burning rate falls within the permissible waste treatment rate, set out in sub category 8.1 of this notice and does not require licensing;
- The permanent immobile petroleum storage facilities at Venetia Mine have a combined storage capacity of 1430.75m³. The combined storage capacity at this site is greater than the storage limit 1000m³ set out in sub category 2.4 of this notice and require licensing;
- Venetia Mine has four diesel generators, each with a design capacity of 2.8MW. The individual design capacity of each generator unit (2.8MW) does not exceed the stipulation of 10MW heat input per unit, for reciprocating engines in subcategory 1.5 of this notice and does not require licensing;
- Based on records taken of the type and quantity of explosive packaging burned from the year 2012, it was determined that an average weight of 128kg of explosive packaging is burned at a time. This burning lasts approximately three hours. Recordings of these burning episodes (±128kg/3hrs) were primarily made on a weekly basis. Burning grounds, as per sub category 8.3 of this notice, are described as facilities where waste material from the manufacture of explosives and contaminated explosive packaging material are destroyed. This applies to all installations disposing of more than 100kg of material per week. The open burning of explosive packaging therefore require licensing.

LOCALITY

Venetia Mine is remote, situated approximately 80km west of the town Musina. (Coordinates of the center of the site: -22.433140°, 29.316836°). The site falls within the Musina Local Municipality and Vhembe District Municipality, Limpopo Province.




Figure 1: Locality of the Site.
