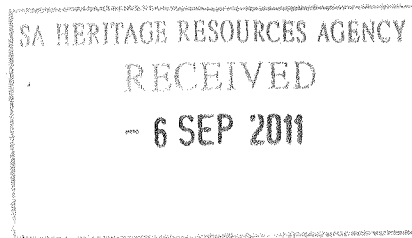

### **INTRODUCTION:**

In terms of the National Environmental Management Waste act 2008 (No 59 of 2008): Proposed new temporary waste site for Bakgatla tribe in Dwaalboom North West and Regulation 67 of GN No R 543 with regard to the period allowed for complying with the requirement of the regulations and Regulation 56 and 57 of GN No R543 with regard to the allowance of the commenting period for the interested and affected parties on all reports submitted.

**Applicant:** Bakgatla Tribe

**Locations:** On the farm Frankfort 219 KP in the Dwaalboom region, Limpopo Province

### **Proposed Activities:**

The proposed project entails the establishment of a jointly owned beef co-operative enterprise by 43 beneficiaries who are the Bakgatla farmers from Dwaalboom. The project will be undertaken on the farm Frankfort, which is located opposite the Rustenburg koppies, in the Thabazimbi Local and Waterberg District Municipality.

The feedlot project involves accommodating 250 weaners and will be at Frankfort farm which measures 3000 hectares. However, the projects will only occupy 10 hectares of the said farm. It is the intention of the Bakgatla to do "back grounding" when necessary. Back-grounding involves holding the animals on pastures for longer periods at lower cost than the feedlots. Whilst still putting on marginal weight thus enabling a reserve of weaners to smoothen out fluctuations in the supply of weaners. For this an additional 400 hectares of natural grazing of the same farm will be utilized, bring the total area to be occupied for the feedlot to 410 hectares.

Cattle manure will be collected weekly from the ten cattle pens and stockpiled in a contained area.

The interested and affected parties are herewith notified of the intent to carry out the following activity:

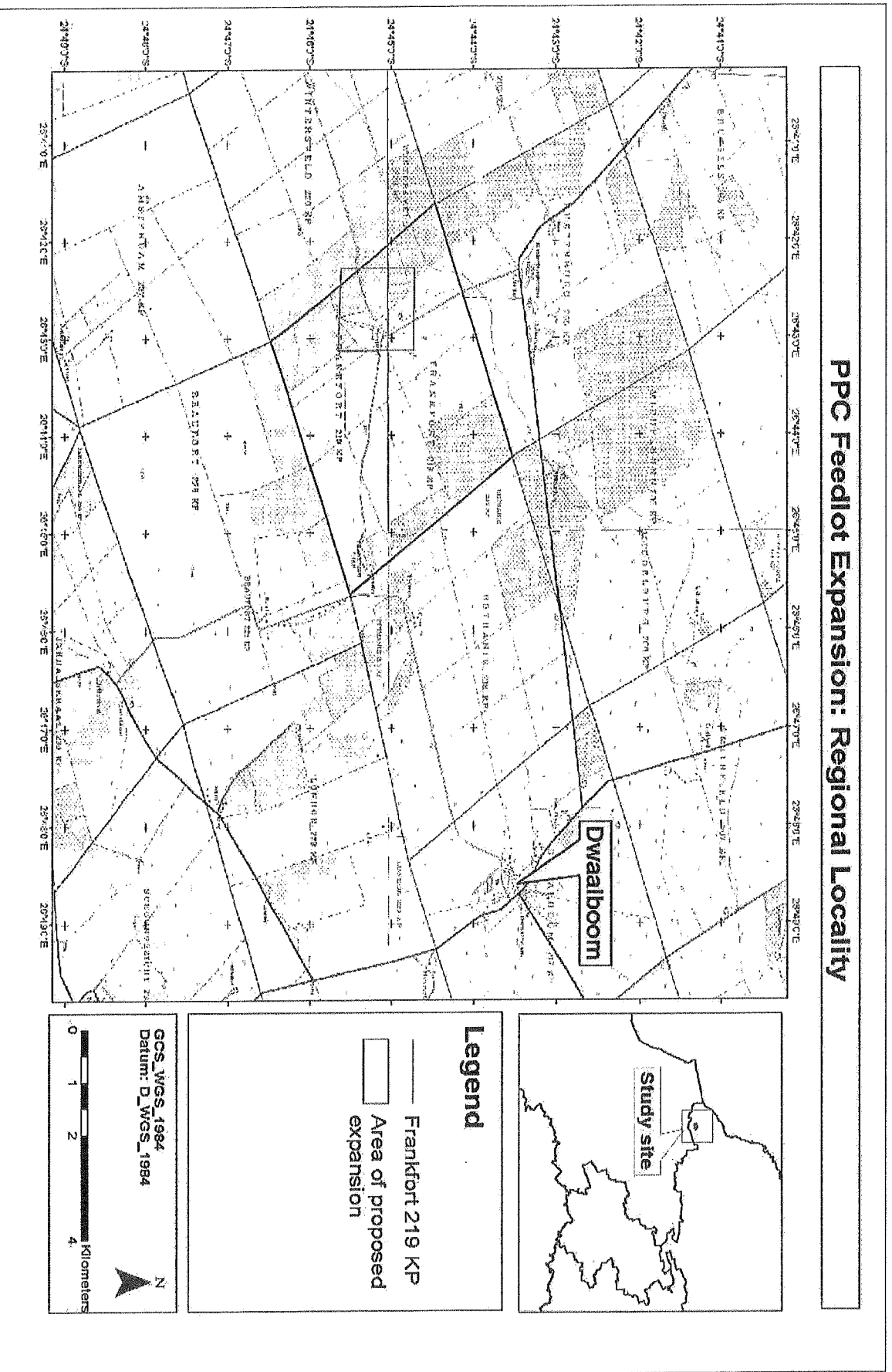
