Elim K.P Naby Bredasdorp maybe of mediocre quality but the experts have decided to keep it because it is rare painting. There are several iconographical photographs examples of Elim but when it comes to paintings these are very rare. I am not an expert, but in the five years that I have spent here at SAHRA, it was my first time to receive an application to export this kind of artwork by Pierneef, it's always various landscape paintings.

I agree with you that there must be sufficient grounds to refuse a permit, but there must be also sufficient grounds to issue a permit.

Please peruse the recommendations and let me know if you still do not agree with experts.

I must agree with the findings of the art panel except in the case of the J. H. Pierneef painting 'Elim K.P Naby Bredasdorp' (80/12/02/019/70). The art panel finds it of "mediocre quality", but nevertheless recommends that it be retained in the republic because it depicts a settlement of historic interest. I cannot see that this is sufficient ground to refuse a permit. It is not as if this is the only known depiction of the settlement, or, indeed, even a definitive one. It is a mediocre one. I can see no grounds to refuse a permit to export this painting.
