See my e-mail (below). <p><i>"I wish to lodge my objection and register as an IAP regarding the mining application lodged by Vaduba Investments CC (Garry Reiger) I have been affected by their indiscriminate bulldozing of land without the necessary Environmental Impact Assessments being carried out, it appears that Vaduba, lead by Garry Reiger do not have any regard for the environment as they have on numerous occasions bulldozed areas on my Eastern and Northern boundaries of Farm 799 portion 20 and actually bulldozed approximately 3000 m2 of my land (without permission) in a very sensitive section along the Gqunube River valley, without any effort to apologise or make good the damage that he has caused. I have tried to get the various authorities to act against Garry Reiger but in vain. Once Vaduba has permission to Mine / Quarry they (Vaduba) will probably continue as they have in the past to give scant regard for the environment and people that are not in a financial position to bring the offenders to book, and be a law unto themselves.
