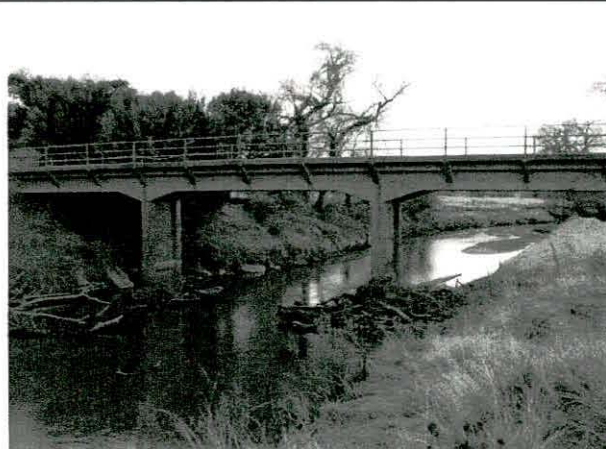


FIG 21: Proposed mine site is located approximately 100m north of this bridge.

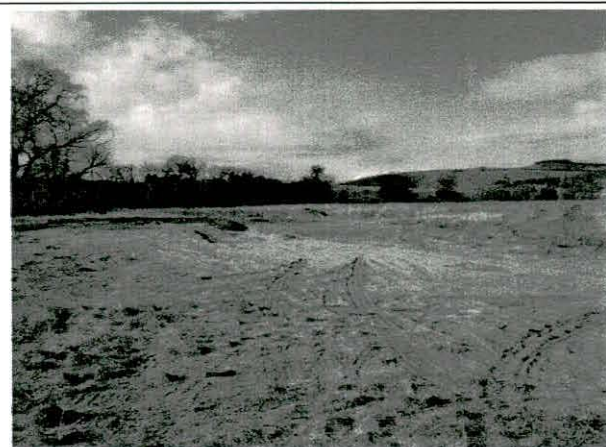


FIG 23: The proposed product stockpile will be located at the previous stockpile site.

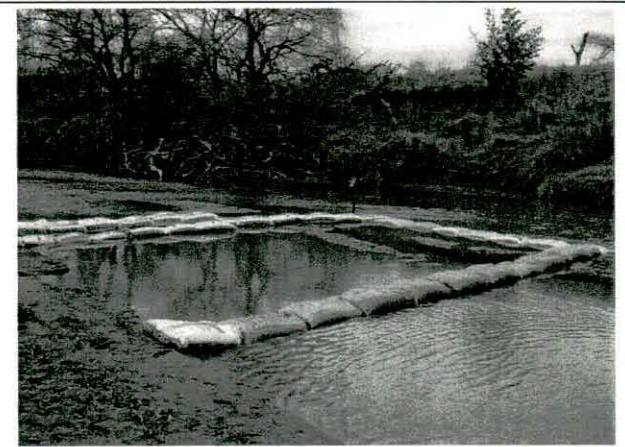


FIG 24: Photo showing a sandbag trial that will form the core of the mining method.

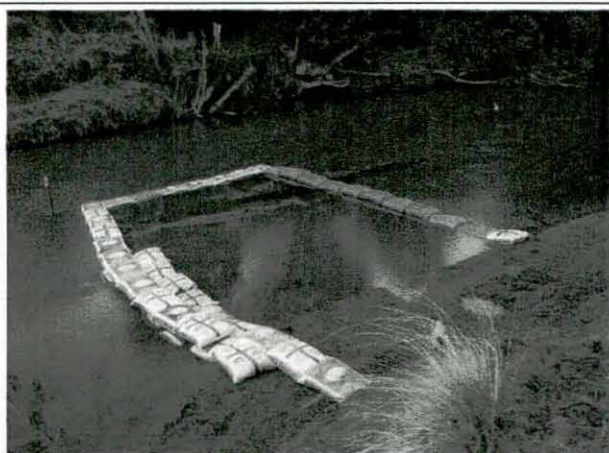


FIG 25: Mining will take place during low river flows and within the isolated pockets.

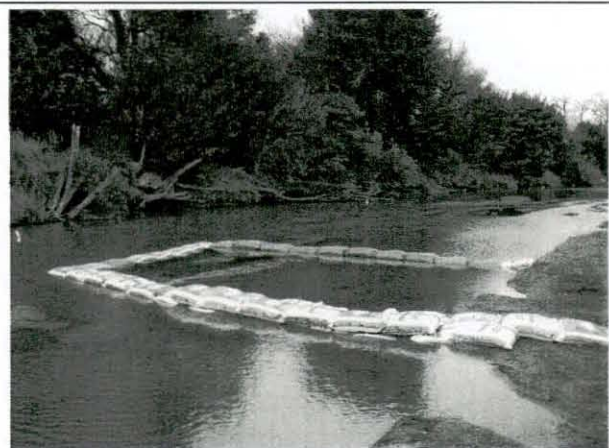


FIG 29: Sandbags will divert the river flow and contain the impacts of sedimentation.

Background information and nature of proposed activity

The proposed sand mining project will take place in Cedarville region of Matatiele Local Municipality on the upper reaches of the Mzimvubu River in the Eastern Cape. The Matatiele Local Municipality forms part of Alfred Nzo District Municipality. The stretch of a river concerned is characterised by sand dominated river bed and river bank. The stretch of the river to be mined on a reach accordingly is thirty meters long. A dragline will be utilised to



remove sand in the river bed underneath the water table while at the same time sand will continuously be deposited in the river bed by the current and discharge of the water.

Alien invasion could also be noticed during the survey (mainly wattle and willows). Plate 1 below shows the site area in Cederville region.

STUDY AREA:

Landuse:

Mainly unimproved grasslands where there cultivated commercial dryland farming is practised, as well as some patches of Thicket, Bushland, Bush Clumps and High Fynbos.

Quaternary Catchment: T31D

Affected River: Mzimvubu River

Vegetation

Consists of Moist Upland Grasland (After Louw and Rebelo, 1996).

Geology and Soils

Tarkastad Formation . Soil type consists of Mudstones and Sandstones

Ecoregions

16 South Eastern Uplands.

Longitudinal profile:

Lower foothills and the river is the second order stream level.

Objectives

The objective of site visit:

- (1) investigate the likely impacts that the impeding and modification of the riverbed may or will pose to the aquatic ecosystem , and,
- (2) Present recommendations and mitigation measures during sand mining process and operational phase that need to be incorporated in an Environmental Management Plan (EMP).

Methodology

- 1: 50 000 topographic maps and Google Earth images: used to find and locate the predetermined survey site, as well as to act as a desktop estimate at a catchment scale.
- ArcView GIS software: for data manipulation, analyses, storage and interpretation of data/metadata Spatsim.
- Site visit: for detailed information and high confidence of biological and environmental assessment, for example: SASS5 used for macroinvertebrate assessment and fluvial geomorphology assessment for physical environmental characteristics.

Observations

The river is perennial much degraded, due to mainly Geology/ soils and associated landuse activities. Landuse on the study area may result in constant sediment deposition especially during rainy seasons.

1. Loss of habitat (physical structure and vegetation).
2. Only gomphid species could be found on the river site, suggesting lack of species diversity and abundance due to inappropriate biotopes for macroinvertebrate biota.
3. Magnitude of environmental impact on the water course – Low to Medium (if prolonged sand mining is carried out.
4. Dredging machine that will be used will result in minimal impact on the flow regime, as it will also abstract the water with sand in the river.

Conclusion and recommendation

1. Rehabilitation of the river bank and the riparian zone including re-plantation of indigenous vegetation.
2. Design of the dragline machine that will be used should not release fuels and oils in the river system, that is, implementation of control measures to hinder pollution of the water resource.
3. Stability of the watercourse should be ensured and scouring/erosion of the watercourse should be prevented.
4. Deposit sand piles outside of 1:50 year flood-line or within an horizontal distance of 100 meters from the watercourse (including wetlands).
5. Apply EIA processes so as to vacate the area as it was before the mining operation.

It is therefore recommended that the proposed sand mining falls within the specification of the new General Authorization (GA), and registered under Section 21 (c) & (i): Diverting the flow of water in a watercourse, altering the river bed, river banks and/or characteristics of the affected streams).

The G.A. and registration would be subject to the following standard conditions:

1. The developer must submit a positive Record of Decision (RoD) from Department of Economic Development and Environmental Affairs (DEDEA) with environmental management program and filled registration forms for non consumptive water use under section 21 (c) and (i) to Department of Water Affairs (DWA) offices in East London.
2. The water use must not cause a potential measurable or cumulative detrimental impact on the characteristics of the water course viz:
 - a) Structures and hardened surfaces associated with water use must not be structural unstable, induce any flooding and be a health and safety hazard
 - b) Change in the stability of the water course.
 - c) Scouring, erosion and sedimentation of a water course; or decline in the diversity of the ecosystem.
 - d) Water quality characteristics of the water course.
 - e) Condition of the aquatic biota, migration of species and physical environment, that is, overall state of the aquatic ecosystem.
3. Rehabilitation measures should be taken into account e.g. re-vegetation with indigenous species, control and destruction of exotic and alien flora/and fauna.
4. Copy of reports on monitoring and reporting should be made available upon written request to the responsible authority.
