Project description: Environmental Authorisation was issued on 10 November 2020 for the Merensky-Uchoba 132kV Powerline Project. This project involves an approximately 18km powerline from the existing Merensky Substation to connect to the Merensky-Jane Furse-Uchoba Powerline T-Off, close to Steelpoort within the Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality, Limpopo Province. Eskom now requires a second deviation of a section of the authorised route to accommodate site-specific problems encountered. This deviation route runs mostly along the R555 and south of the Steelpoort River. It is approximately 10,6km in length of which approximately 5,5km falls within the International Strategic Transmission Corridor; hence the application for registration in terms of the Standard refer to above.
